Scheme Description	The surfacing in Broughton depot is showing signs of deterioration due to the age of the surfacing and because of winter maintenance activities. Surfacing defects are evident around the depot which are becoming hazardous. These could lead to slips, trips and/or falls. Maintenance costs will increase if improvements are not carried out. It is proposed to resurface the affected areas with a suitable material to ensure the longevity of the surfacing			

#### **Exemption Statement**
