


Back bar support fixed into clear or frosted acrylic sheet. Back bar is fixed into (welded or screw fixed) a steel horizontal rod. This rod screw fixes into case back panel. Front view Back view Distances vary. NAM conservation team and vertical mount maker to agree metal types and positions of fixings 183 Dimension given is an example but they are all taken from back of acrylic sheet to the case back panel All steel parts spray painted with appropriate RAL colour finish angled Side view

Used for lighter objects, prints, lithographs, miniatures, medals etc

**TYPE G** Used for objects needing several ring or claw fixings to fix into case back panel ie rifles, spears, fork etc Fixed to case back panel

TYPE H

Used for uniforms, jackets, helmets, hats etc

where posts can't be used

150 Steel or brass claws or cradle armature to capture object. May need special armature inside. NAM conservation team and mount maker to agree metal types and positions of fixings Two or more steel horizontal rods screw fix into case back panel. Distances vary. All steel parts spray painted with appropriate RAL colour finish TYPE L Fixed to case back panel Used for large, heavy objects ie Zulu shield, case 7 **MOUNT TYPES 2/3**
