

Addendum

Refurbishment of Rope Walk Playground, Rope Walk, Homs Road, Ross-on-Wye, Herefordshire for Ross-on-Wye Town Council.

1. Surfacing:

The contractor should adhere to the API's Code of Practice for the provision of attenuating surfaces. The detailed schedule of work should include details of suitable ground preparation to be undertaken before any rubber mulch or wet pour surface is laid.

Please include length and extent of the warranty of all surfacing used.

2. Fencing:

Existing fencing may be re-used and properly installed and additional fencing should match.

3. Equipment:

When itemising a piece of equipment, details of if and how it may be suitable for disabled children should be included.

4. Health and Safety:

The contractor will operate in conformity to all current Health & Safety legislation, including COSHH and The Duty of Care Directive, Environmental Protection 1990, relating to Waste Management.

5. Design

Any applicant is welcome to submit an alternative design provided it complies with all the requirements of the council.

6. Work on Site:

The council has a large secure yard a quarter of a mile from the site which can be used for temporary storage while working on site.

Access to the field where the playground is located is via a short lane from Edde Cross Street and a gate for which the key will be loaned to the contractor for the duration of work on site.

During the work, appropriate safety fencing, comfort facilities for workers and a skip for any waste material should be provided by the contractor.
