| We assume it is possible to apply for this as a collaboration/partnership? Is there any extra information needed to apply as a partnership, or extra guidance needed? | 29/11/2022 - pm | I can confirm that whilst it is possible to collaborate on the tender, Saltash Town Council as the accountable body for this project would require one of the companies to be the lead organisation to coordinate the works and be the responsible company with whom it would contract should the tender be successful. It would then be the responsibility of the lead company to subcontract with the other companies to deliver on the elements assigned to them by the lead company. The lead company would be the one signing the quotation form and for whom all the governance checks would apply and a key point of contact would need to be identified as per the specification. | 30/11/2022 - am |
| Can you show us the 6 sites that you are thinking about as it will help us to understand the scope and requirements much better? | 29/11/2022 - pm | The potential sites are areas that The Saltash Town Team have identified as possible opportunities due to their proximity to the retail centre. As a small town, it is anticipated that there are no more than 6 sites that would be suitable to consider but the successful consultant may indeed rule some of these out early on or indeed identify other options that are viable to progress. | Are Cornwall Council part of the client body? Will they provide ownership and OS title information which saves on costs. | 2/12/2022 -pm | Saltash Town Council is the accountable body for this project. However, there is Cornwall Councillor representation on The Saltash Town Team and the funding for the project has come from Cornwall Council's Town Vitality Funding. | What traffic data do you already have? | 2/12/2022 -pm | To answer this question, I have been in touch with CORMAC who have confirmed that they have manual traffic and pedestrian counts (single weekday in April), every year up to and including 2019. Also, there's an automatic counter (24/7) on The Bridge slip roads - Fore Street and North Road. | 6/12/2022 - pm |
| What traffic managements are put in place for various town events? | 2/12/2022 -pm | Where Saltash Town Council hosts events that require traffic management including road closures, appropriate paperwork is submitted to Cornwall Council. This has included the closure of Fore Street. Other event organisers would also need to apply to Cornwall Council following the same process. | 6/12/2022 - pm |
