 - (2) That the Sub-Contractor will save harmless and indemnify the Contractor from and against any negligence by the Sub-Contractor his agents workmen or servants and from and against a any misuse by him or them of any Constructional Plant or Temporary Works provided by the Contractor or the purpose of the Contract and from all claims as aforesaid.
4. Any award of a sub-contract will be subject to the Sub-Contractor meeting the requirements of the main contract programme.
5. GRAHAM reserve the right to split the order for any sub-contract work if this is required for the economical and expeditious execution of the work.
6. All offers are deemed to include 2.5% discount unless otherwise stated.
