

Fly Tipping on the Station (an extract from Station Routine Orders)

Instances of fly tipping on the Station are on the increase. Asbestos roofing sheets, ironing boards, rotary clothes lines, garden waste, motor parts and electrical goods such as TV sets, irons, fridges, vacuum cleaners are but a few of the items recently found in and piled against the various waste bins around the Station.

THIS PRACTICE IS TO CEASE IMMEDIATELY.

Removal of this unsuitable and sometimes illegal waste costs the Station funds that could be spent in far better ways. If personnel have domestic items to dispose of, they are to take them to the nearest designated Council Recycling/Domestic Waste Facility. Details of your nearest domestic waste facility can be found on the reverse of this leaflet or contact the Station Waste Coordinator on ext 7725.



Trade Waste

Trade waste is any refuse that is created in your work place and should be disposed of in the large Blue Bins. (Some of these bins are for cardboard only and are labelled accordingly).

Please DO NOT leave rubbish piled up outside of these bins as it attracts vermin, is unsightly and will not be collected.



Bulk Trade Waste

Bulk trade waste can be disposed of by contacting Supply on ext.6572 or the Station Waste Co-ordinator on ext.7725

Hazardous Trade Waste

All types of hazardous waste can be disposed of by contacting Supply.

Domestic Waste SFA's (Service Families' Accommodation)

Please read the Refuse/Recycling leaflet provided by North Kesteven District Council for information on collection dates and what refuse can be placed in which bin.



Domestic Waste SLAs

Two types of bin are supplied for Single Living Accommodation (SLA), a black lidded bin for general household waste and a green lidded bin for recyclable material.

(PLEASE DO NOT USE BLACK BIN BAGS FOR RECYCLEABLE WASTE).

These bins are emptied fortnightly and should not be used for electrical items, bulk or hazardous waste.

Please **DO NOT** leave rubbish piled up outside of these bins as it attracts vermin, is unsightly and will not be collected.

Cans
All Steel and Aluminium Cans, Aerosol Cans (Empty), Clean Aluminium Foil

Paper
Newspaper, Magazines, Writing Paper, Envelopes, Junk Mail, Directories

Textiles
Clothes, Curtains, Pairs of Shoes (Tied together), Blankets, Sheets

Landfill
Anything that can't be recycled

Domestic Bulk & Hazardous Waste

Domestic waste can be taken to the household waste recycling centres around the district free of charge. Their opening times are below: (please note that during the summer months some sites may stay open later)

Alternatively North Kesteven District council provides a collection from domestic properties for both domestic and electrical items.

The charge from April 1st 2011 will be:

Electrical items (eg TV, washing machine, fridge, PC)

£10.00 for up to 3 items £20.00 for up to 6 items

Domestic items (eg bed, chair, carpet)

£10.00 for up to 3 items £20.00 for up to 6 items
