Poringland Burial Ground Grounds Maintenance 2018 Season

Site address:

Burial Ground Rectory Lane Poringland NR14 7SL

Duration of contract: 1st April 2018 to 31st March 2019

Poringland Burial Ground – General Maintenance

- 1. Top and trim hedges twice annually June and September.
- 2. Keep full width of the path weed free. Paths to have weed killer applied and all arisings to be removed from site. Type of weed killer to be notified to Parish Clerk prior to commencement of contract.
- 3. Cut whole grass area every two weeks and remove clippings from site following each cutting. Quotation to include allowing for winter grass trimming.
- 4. Maintain all boundary banks.
- 5. Cut grassed area either side of the gate near the road.
- 6. Edge around slab bases, memorial plaques and concrete grave markers annually.
- 7. Supply and apply granular weed feed and moss killer. Scarify area removing as much moss as possible.

Poringland Burial Ground – Ad Hoc Maintenance (price per grave)

- 1. Level and turf graves at least six months after interment (to be requested by Clerk, normally more than one to be completed at a time).
- 2. To attend site within 5 hours of a request to fill in a collapsed grave. (this work would be carried out during daylight hours but may include weekends if health a safety dictates).

Note: All infilling and levelling works can be completed using the spoil heap located at the bottom of the burial ground.

Contractors will be required to provide evidence of Public Liability Insurance prior to commencement of work, and may be asked to provide a risk assessment on request. Contractors are asked to supply copies of PA1 and PA6 spray certificates and to forward COSHH sheets for any chemicals used.





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Poringland Community Centre Grounds Maintenance 2018 Season

New items marked in yellow

Poringland Community Centre

- 1. Cut grass in front of Community Centre and collect clippings, on a fortnightly basis.
- 2. Cut grass and strim in front of Police Station and collect clippings on a fortnightly basis.
- 3. To cut the large area to the rear of the Community Centre (to the gap in the hedge line leading onto the large field), clippings to be collected, on a fortnightly basis.
- 4. To strim around the pond area twice per year.
- 5. To spend one day clearing pond of weed and overgrown shrubs once per vear.
- 6. To keep borders and areas around trees and shrubs weed free.
- 7. To trim the hedge in front of the Library and between the Community Centre and the Village Green.
- 8. To spray off weeds around the Community Centre as required, including the brick weave path between the Community Centre and Mulberry Close.
- 9. Supply and apply granular weed feed and moss killer. Scarify area removing as much moss as possible.

All grass cuttings, hedge trimmings and other garden refuse to be removed from site.

Any work undertaken within the perimeter of the pond fence must be done with a minimum of two operatives present. Key to be gained from office, and life belt must be requested to be put out.

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Poringland Devlin Drive and Blackthorn Way Grounds Maintenance 2018 Season

Play Area and Grassed Area Devlin Drive and Blackthorn Way Poringland NR14 7WA

Duration of contract: 1st April 2018 to 31st March 2019.

New items marked in yellow

Play Area

- 1. To strim around all trees, shrubs and play equipment on a fortnightly basis.
- 2. To box cut all grassed areas on a fortnightly basis.

Play Marked Area (within hedge)

- 1. To cut the inside of the hedge twice per annum, disposing of arisings.
- 2. To sweep the play marked surface once per month, keeping free of moss and weeds, and dispose of arisings.
- 3. To spray weeds emerging from under hedge or around building four times per annum.

Paths

- 1. To cut the outside of the hedge twice per annum, disposing of arisings.
- 2. To spray the brick weave paths around the play area and between the play marked area and the grass four times per annum.

Grass Areas

- 1. To box cut areas behind play area and over path in front of play area on a fortnightly basis. Price to include removal of all grass clippings.
- 2. To box cut two areas on Blackthorn Way on a fortnightly basis. Price to include removal of all grass clippings.

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Poringland Memorial Garden Grounds Maintenance 2018 Season

Poringland Leisure Garden

- 1. Cut grass every two weeks, including grass on sloping sides of pond.
- 2. Keep borders and areas around trees and shrubs weed free.
- 3. Trim all hedges once annually.
- 4. Prune shrubs and trees annually in the autumn.
- 5. Take away from site all grass cuttings, hedge trimmings and other garden refuse.
- 6. Supply and apply granular weed feed and moss killer. Scarify area removing as much moss as possible.
- 7. Clean pond once per annum (1 day, 2 people).
- 8. Clear weeds from footpath regularly.
- 9. Clean War Memorial (warm soapy water available from the Community Centre) every quarter (with one scheduled for the week before Remembrance Sunday, together with leaf clearance and general tidy up)

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Poringland Delegated Verge Cutting 2018 Season

Site address (outlined in green below):

Throughout Poringland

Duration of contract: 1st April 2018 to 31st March 2019.

1. To cut verges within Poringland according to the specification set out within this tender, which is the Norfolk County Council delegated specification.

Contractors will be required to provide evidence of Public Liability Insurance prior to commencement of work, and may be asked to provide a risk assessment on request.

Appendix A

Service Specification: The Delegated Service

- 1. Cutting shall be carried out in a careful and safe manner and shall be in accordance with the areas shown on the drawings and schedule.
- 2. The maximum finished cut height shall be 50mm and will not normally exceed 150mm before being cut.
- 3. Grass shall be cut right up to road signs, marker posts, lighting columns etc. by hand or strimmer. This work will be completed within the same week (7 calendar days) as the mowing is carried out. The cost of this work shall be included in the appropriate mowing rates.
- 4. All areas shall be cut up to 5 times per season. Flail mowers shall not be used for this cutting.
- 5. Sites of Specific Scientific Interest (SSSI's) will be subject to different standards. These standards will be detailed by the Engineer as necessary.
- 6. Linear Habitats and Licensed Verges will be subject to different standards. These standards will be detailed by the Engineer as necessary.

Appendix C

Guidance Notes

The Plant supplied for the Service must be licensed and insured to comply with current regulations.

Vehicles used as Plant shall be fitted with a cab mounted flashing amber light which must be operating when engaged in grass cutting. Each vehicle must also carry alternative red and yellow reflective markings in accordance with SI 1989 No 1796 (Lighting Regulations on Vehicles) and BA AU 152 (Specification for Rear Marking Plates for Vehicles) 1970 (Rev 1990), and an arrow mounted on the rear of the cutting unit (See sub-Clause 4.5).

All operatives must wear high visibility clothing to BS EN471:1994, Class 3, incorporating additional reflective materials for extra safety, boots with steel toe-caps and, where appropriate, helmets, all to be provided by the Contractor. This also applies to where plant is being delivered to work sites.


Traffic Signs

- 4.1 The Contractor shall at all times comply with Chapter 8 of the Traffic Signs Manual. 'Traffic Safety Measures for Roadworks' as appropriate (published by TSO in 2006).
- 4.2 Warning signs used shall be Class 1 retroreflective signs to Table 1 of BS EN12899 -1:2001. Triangular signs shall be minimum size 750mm and wording of supplementary plates shall be to minimum 'x' height of 62.5mm.
- 4.3 Particular requirements for single carriageways shall be:
 - Sign to Diagram 7001 (Road works Ahead) with supplementary plate to diagram 7001.1 with legend "Grass Cutting" to be provided and erected on both approaches to all cutting vehicles. The maximum distance between opposing signs shall be 1 mile. (Any reference to sign diagrams in these Guidance Notes relate to 'The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002' and its amendments of 2004 and 2005).
- 4.4 Road Works Ahead signs should be sited in order that all approaching drivers from either direction and road junctions shall have been adequately warned of the operation by passing at least one warning sign erected in a clear and legible position in advance of the cutting operation.
- 4.5 A Keep Left / Right sign (as appropriate) to Diagram 610 shall be provided. Sign diameter to be 600mm minimum.
- 4.6 All signs shall be maintained in a clean and legible condition.

Mulberry Village Green

- 1. Harrow and roll in spring.
- 2. Gangmow twice per month from mid-March to the end of October inclusive, including The Ridings side of the hedge to the west of the land.
- 3. Scarify and aerate in November/December.

Duration of contract: 1st April 2018 – 31st March 2019

Play Areas

To strim around all play equipment on a fortnightly basis.

To box cut all grassed areas on a fortnightly basis.

To spray underneath railings four times per annum.

Trees and Hedges

To strim nettles and brambles from under hedges and at boundary with Heath Loke monthly.

To tidy any damaged or overhanging branches from small trees either side of Village Green as required

To cut hedge top and sides to east once per annum, maintaining to fence height up to boundary with properties on Mulberry Close. To leave height of mature hedge between Village Green and Community Centre.

To cut hedge to west both sides once per annum.

Note that the hedge to the south, beyond the pavement, does not belong to the Parish Council and should not be cut.

Paths

To spray paths four times per annum, keeping free of weeds and encroachment of grass.

Miscelleneous

To spray paving in Youth Shelter four times per annum, keeping free of weeds and encroachment of grass.

To spray weeds around dog and litter bins, benches etc four times per annum. To cut back shrubs on piece of land in south east corner, adjacent to 22 Devlin Drive.

Playing Field Grass Cutting

- 1. Harrow and roll in spring.
- 2. Gangmow twice per month from mid-March to the end of October inclusive.
- 3. Scarify and aerate in November/December.

Duration of contract: 1st April 2018 – 31st March 2019

Play Area

To strim around all trees, shrubs and play equipment on a fortnightly basis.

To box cut all grassed areas on a fortnightly basis.

Cut hedge twice in season, check shrubs and trees for damage, cut back any branches in need of pruning.

Car Park

To strim and cut grass area running alongside ditch on a fortnightly basis.

To strim far side of ditch on a monthly basis.

To cut small grassed area outside gate on a fortnightly basis.

To strim area on other side of fence running parallel with ditch on a regular basis.

Strim around concrete bollards at car park as required.

Apply herbicide and remove weeds in car park as required.

Clean ditch from gate to boundary with 23 The Footpath once in June, removing all arisings.

Boundary of Field

<u>Shrubs east side</u> - Strim around shrubs, apply herbicides if needed. Prune shrubs twice maintaining at no higher than fence height, prune back any damaged or overhanging branches.

<u>Hedge north side</u> - Flail to hedge line and cut hedge to fence height once during contract period (up to and including old gun club site).

Ditch west side - Flail to ditch line once per season before football season.

Old Gun Club Site - Strim whole area once in November (to be maintained as a wildlife area).

Bowls Club

Cut back shrub hedge between path and bowling green twice per season. Cut back growth overhanging the path as required.

Cut back and top of hedge on outside of east boundary and cut back hedge on west boundary as high as possible.

Football Pitch Railings

Strim grass under railings as required, spray base of railing posts.

Pavilion Area

To box cut area around the pavilion on a fortnightly basis. Price to include removal of all grass clippings.

Apply herbicide and remove weeds in paving as required.

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Rosebery Park, Shotesham Road Grounds Maintenance 2018 Season

Duration of contract: 1st April 2018 – 31st March 2019.

Year Round Tasks

Litter pick site once per week and dispose of arisings. Inspect and sweep paving one per month. Inspect and sweep play area matting once per month. Leaf collection once per month, dispose of arisings.

Seasonal (mid-March to end-October) Tasks

Cut amenity grass areas and strim margins fortnightly (16 occasions per annum). Weeding of planted areas once per month (7 occasions per annum).

Check and adjust plant supports/ties once per month (7 occasions per annum).

Tidy beds and top up bark mulch levels as necessary (7 occasions per annum) Spot herbicide of planted areas (4 occasions per annum).

Water shrubs and trees fortnightly in dry spells (12 occasions per annum) - (water supplied on site)

Trim and tie climbers once per month (7 occasions per annum).

Trim hedges twice per annum, shaping sides and maintaining height to an agreed specification.

Prune trees and shrubs twice per annum.

Fertilise trees and shrubs twice per annum.

Edge amenity grass areas with half moon took twice per annum.

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Poringland Trafalgar Square / Victory Avenue Grounds Maintenance 2018 Season

Duration of contract: 1st April 2018 – 31st March 2019

Play area and large grassed area

To strim around all trees, shrubs and play equipment on a fortnightly basis.

To box cut all grassed areas on a fortnightly basis.

Cut shrubs back twice in season, ensuring they do not encroach past the railings, check trees for damage, cut back any branches in need of pruning, dispose of arisings.

Grassed area behind BT box

To box cut grass area running the length of the verge behind the BT boxes on a fortnightly basis.

To cut back the shrubs and brambles between the grass and the fence twice per annum, ensuring that they are kept well back and cut hard if necessary, dispose of arisings.

Grassed area along Victory Avenue

To cut grass area running the length of the verge shown on the map, to just past opposite Nelson Close.

To cut the one side and top of the hedge running along the same stretch, being mindful not to damage the trees contained within the hedge.

Bronze Sculpture, Blackthorn Way

Cut back the shrubs maintaining tidily within the railings four times per annum.

Miscelleneous

Cut back shrubs next to electricity sub station twice per annum.

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
