KEY

Proposed improved surface - refer to MSN656/Drg03
- Woodland Edge Ground Flora
 - Excessive re-growth of scrub & brambles to be controlled by phased cutting.
 - Grass areas to be sown with shade tolerant / woodland seed mix.
 - New planting to include native understorey & hedgerow shrubs, bulbs and woodland edge wildflowers.
- Longer Grass margins
 - Areas of cut back bramble and scrub to be controlled in accordance with ecological advice to develop grass sward.
 - Thereafter to be cut to provide 30cm high grass adjacent to woodland edge, and 15cm high sward adjacent to close mown grass in accord with ecological advice.
- Close-Mown Grass
 - Prior to works, existing uneven grass will have been close mown / strimmed (between 1 April and 30 September) to avoid potential as reptile and amphibian habitat.
 - Strip top 75mm of soil / vegetation from area and retain for re-use to preserve existing seed bank.
 - Undertake regrading work at either end of meadow and re-grade remaining areas to provide more even, flowing contours.
 - Re-spread preserved top layer of soil and seed with a grass / wildflower mix suitable for seasonal close mowing.
