THIS CONTRACT is made the 29th day of March 2022

Between:

- 1. Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors (RICS) whose principal place of business is 55 Colmore Row, Birmingham, B3 2AA; and
- 2. Valuation Office Agency 8th Floor, 10 South Colonnade, London, E14 4PU

Terms and Conditions

isurv ('the Service') is supplied by RICS. Valuation Office Agency is a Subscriber (as defined below).

The Service contains materials, documents and information ('Materials') from many sources and contributors ('Contributors') and is updated by RICS from time to time. The following Terms and Conditions apply to use of the Service by individual subscribers ('Subscribers'), by employees or companies duly authorised by an organisation that is a Subscriber or any other person authorised by RICS ('Authorised Users'). References to an 'Unauthorised Person' mean any person who is neither a Subscriber nor an Authorised User.

1. Acceptance of Terms and Conditions
