1 Scheme Type

This scheme is a value band B (£30k to £250k) Road Renewal Scheme.

2 Scheme Description

The purpose of this scheme is to repair an embankment slip adjacent to an all purpose dual carriageway road. The embankment slip covers a maximum embankment height of 8m and extends for approximately 40m. The existing embankment is of approximate grade 1 in 2 which is to be maintained following the works.

The works will include but are not limited to:

- Provision of temporary accommodation or all necessary facilities to meeting health and safety requirements;
- General site clearance;
- Removal of cabinet and base;
- Provision and installation of information boards;
- Replacement of gullies, gratings and frames in the vicinity of the earthworks including amendments to associated piped drainage, filter drains and connections;
- Excavate and disposal of not more than 2500m³ of acceptable and unacceptable material. Importing acceptable material Class 1A and reinstatement of the original embankment profile, including any necessary benching works;
- Reinstatement of topsoil and landscaping to affected area.

3 Road category on which the work is to be carried out

The works will take place on a dual two lane all-purpose dual carriageway (rural – greater than 40 mph) road.

4 Traffic Management

The provision of traffic management is outside the scope of this scheme.

5 Period within which the work is to be carried out

The works are to be carried out within Time Band 1.

6 Site Restrictions and Constraints

The following restrictions and constraints exist at the works location:

• The carriageway has no hard strips at the location of the work.

7 Indicative Programme and Season within which the work is to be carried out

The works are to be completed within 4 weeks.

The majority of the works are to be constructed during British Summer Time.
