DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF PUMP TRACK for completion by 31 March 2022

Tenders are invited for the design and construction of a pump track to be located at Sharpham Road playing fields for Cheddar Parish Council as set down below and should be submitted in writing to **Cheddar Parish Council, Parish Hall, Church Street, Cheddar, Somerset BS27 3RA**, in a sealed marked envelope to the Parish Clerk no later than noon on Friday 5th November 2021.

The deadline of 31 March 2022 is due to funding time restrictions. By tendering you agree to this timescale.

Cheddar Parish Council is looking for a contractor to:

- Provide a high-quality track design with features for bicycles, scooters and skateboards. The track design should provide features suitable for a variety of users including alternative lines for more experienced riders. The track design should fully utilise the area detailed in the site plan whilst ensuring that no parts of the track or banks encroach on easement zones for Bristol Water pipes
- Provide a high-quality fine asphalt surface suitable for bicycles, scooters and skateboards
- Blend the track into playing fields with grass banks and islands
- Utilise materials gifted by Hanson UK
 - 1,768 tonnes of Type 1 aggregates (supplied from Batts Combe quarry)
 - 174 tonnes asphalt (supplied from Batts Combe asphalt plant – hardstone aggregates supplied from Brayford quarry)
- Utilise, reshape or remove mound of earth to the south of the track on rugby club land
- Provide details of how construction materials will be brought to site whilst protecting pipes running under the site. Provide details of liability insurance particularly in relation to any potential damage to pipes occurring from construction works
