1. For the purposes of the Agreement, the Customer and the Supplier agree as follows:

1.2. The charges for the Services shall be as set out in Annex 2. The total contract value shall be £99,841.00 capped cost.

1.3. There will be no charge made by the Supplier for face-to-face review meetings as the cost will be absorbed into other milestone prices, as confirmed in their bid clarification and set out in Annex 5.

1.4. The specification of the Services to be supplied is as set out in Annex 3 and within the Supplier’s response at Annex 4 subject to any clarifications as set out in Annex 5. Where there is conflict Annex 3 shall take precedence.

1.5. The Term shall commence on 24/04/17 (the “Start Date”) and the Expiry Date shall be 27/09/17, with no option to extend.
