Whereas the Contractor (Caisley Eartag Limited) and the Authority entered into a Contract for the Supply of DNA Ear Tagging of TB Reactors dated 01/10/2014 (the "Original Contract") and now wish to amend the Original Contract.

It is agreed as follows:

1. With effect from 01/10/2018 the Original Contract shall be amended as set out in this Contract Change Note:

Summary of Change	Extension of existing contract by one year to 30/09/2019.	
Reason for Change	An extension avoids the significant inconvenience and substantial duplication of costs arising from the replacement of 1500 ear tag applicators that are distributed to vet practices throughout England, Wales and Scotland to carry out bovine TB tests at a time where there is uncertainty regarding the government's mandate on the TB programme going forward following initial publication of the Godfray review in October 2018. Applicators of a particular supplier are not universal or interchangeable due to varying size and components. At this point, given the uncertainty surrounding the scope and parameters of the TB programme going forward (including the use of any particular ear tag), there would be significant inconvenience and substantial duplication of costs for APHA to purchase and send new applicators to all of the relevant vet practices in the UK (and educate the practices on their use), as well as organise the disposal of the old applicators.
