#### Reason for change

Further to clause 3, Schedule 5 HEE wishes to extend Project EnED into a phase 2 running from 01 April 2021 – 31 January 2022.

#### **Description of Change**

Further to Clause 3, Schedule 5, HEE wishes to include within the contract, the following work packages as part of Project EnED.
