Annex B: Amendment to Vaccine Shelf Life.

Changes to original contract specification outlined below.

Schedule 1 – Specification

Sections 3.1 and 7.1 on the original Specification are replaced with the wording below:

3. Purpose

3.1. The Authority requires access to 750,000 (seven hundred and fifty thousand) doses of live attenuated Neethling strain Vaccine against LSD to be available for delivery to the UK within a maximum of 10 (ten) calendar days of a request by the Authority. Such Vaccine must have at least 3 (three) months remaining shelf life at the point of delivery to the UK, unless delivery is in March 2025, where a minimum of 2 (two) months remaining shelf life has been agreed.

7. Requirements for the delivery of the Vaccine

7.1. Within a maximum of 10 (ten) working days of a request by the Authority, the Supplier is required to deliver up to 750,000 (seven hundred and fifty thousand) doses to a place in the UK as specified by the Authority at the time of request. Such Vaccine must have at least 3 (three) months remaining shelf life at the point of delivery to the UK, unless delivery is in March 2025, where a minimum of 2 (two) months remaining shelf life has been agreed.
