	Procurement of a new tractor and trailer package, to replace the existing equipment currently in use.
1.3	Background

	The RTO Group manages the Range Facility at Dstl Porton Down and operates a wide array of heavy plant & equipment in support of R&D trial programme, undertaken on a high-frequency basis.
	RTO Group manages its fleet of equipment in accordance with its internal Plant & Equipment Strategy, reviewed and re-prioritised annually.
	Current equipment:
	One of the predominant machines in the fleet is a large agricultural tractor primarily used for road haulage tasks, which is now a priority for replacement & upgrade due to high utilisation, advancing age, deteriorating condition and escalating maintenance costs.
	The RTO Group are looking to purchase a replacement large tractor for their long-term (>10yr) needs, and trade-in their current machine against a brand new, fully warrantied unit.
	The new machine must provide the highest standards of safety, reliability and operational capabilities, whilst minimising down-time and repair costs.
	Additionally, the RTO Group also intends to source a heavy duty flat-bed trailer , with integrated ISO container twist-locks, to facilitate routine movement of 10ft & 20ft ISO containers. The existing 2018 26ft bale trailer is light duty and not fit for this purpose. This trailer will be traded-in, along with the current tractor, as part of the new equipment procurement deal.

Source two brand-new items of agricultural equipment procured as a package deal, from a single supplier:

Tractor

General points

- Brand new machine
- Expedient procurement a priority requirement, within early FY23/24
- Dealer held stock preferable to a long lead-time factory order
- Very nearly new, low hour units may also be considered but only if brand new units are unavailable in timescale from any other source
- 5 Year / 2000hr warranty option must be included in offered deal
- Currently owned & operated tractor must be accepted as a trade-in

Required Machine Specification

- 150 -175 engine horsepower required (boost function may provide more)
- Stage-V engine, with high fuel efficiency and low emissions
- Minimum 50kph top speed
- Front axle suspension
- Cab suspension
- Simplified transmission option(s) preferred
- Minimum of 3 spool valves at rear, with simplified mechanical controls preferred over complex electronic systems
- Air & hydraulic braking circuits for trailers
- Hydraulic extendable hitch
- 3 speed PTO 540/540E/1000
- Hydraulic front 3-point linkage
- Front weight block
- Cabin climate control, with air conditioning
- Full width front and rear mud guards
- Buddy / Trainer seat

Trade-in unit:

- 2013 Kubota M130X (Reg GJ13 ACX)
- 1700hrs (will increase)
- 4 new tyres (all >95%)
- Front weights package
- Fully maintained, good condition
