Background

- Manifesto commitment to pay tribute to the contribution of the UK's Caribbean community over the generations
- Project led by Government (MHCLG) but with crucial input/advice from the Windrush Commemoration Committee
- Fitting monument to be placed inside London's Waterloo Station
- Working at pace to meet key milestone



Role of prospective supplier

- Specialist arts consultancy to:
 - Deliver an artist's brief
 - Develop a long list of prospective artists, with particular regard to cultural relevance
 - Launch a competition for designs
 - Serve as a 'critical friend' to MHCLG's project team, providing feedback on the project timeline, budget breakdown and sequencing of the project



Role of prospective supplier (continued)

- Run a competition for artists' proposals
- Invite long-listed artists to submit bids
- Oversee assessment of all bids
- Advise Committee on reviewing and approving a shortlist of designs
- Identify an 'up and coming' architect to collaborate with the artist on the design of the plinth.



Role of prospective supplier (continued)

- Commission each shortlisted artist to produce a maquette
- Support that MHCLG's engagement with the British Caribbean community to be well-structured and wide-reaching
- Support committee and MHCLG to consider the findings of the public engagement exercise and arrive at a decision on the final design
- Draft a design contract with successful artist and architect





Delivery partners

Throughout this process the arts consultant will be working closely with:


- **Ministry of Housing, Communities and Local Government**, who will lead the overall management of the project
- **Windrush Commemoration Committee**, who will provide advice on what form the tribute should take, as well as high-level issues, such as the selection of an artist to design the monument
- **Windrush Monument cross-government working group**, a group of officials who have previously worked on projects to create a range of monuments and memorials around the country. They provide advice and guidance based on their experience
- **Network Rail**, site owners of London Waterloo Station, providing advice on technical items relating to the monument's installation and ongoing maintenance and security
- **London Borough of Lambeth**, as the relevant local authority (some collaboration may be required; however, we do not anticipate planning permission will be necessary as the monument is situated wholly indoors at London Waterloo Station)
- **Construction consultant** (in the later phases), who will oversee the fabrication and installation of the monument


