



Z31 Price Adjustment for Inflation TSC

The Client recognises the ongoing pricing uncertainty with regard to inflation. The Client will mitigate this uncertainty through this clause.

Z31.1 Defined terms:

- a) The index is Office for National Statistics (ONS) CPI (UK, 2015=100).
- b) The Base Date Index (B) is the latest available index published by ONS prior to the Contract Date.
- c) The Latest Index (L) is the latest available index published by ONS before the date of assessment of an amount due.
- The Price Adjustment Factor (PAF) at each date of assessment of an amount due is 0.9((L-B)/B).

Z31.2 Application rules.

The provisions of this clause [Z31] shall apply provided that:

- a) The Price for Service Provided to Date is less than or equal to the total of the Prices and
- Inflation remains positive ie L is greater than B.

Z31.3 Price Adjustment Factor.

If an index is changed after it has been used in calculating a PAF, the calculation is not changed. The PAF calculated at the last assessment date before the Completion Date for the whole of the works is used for calculating an amount for price adjustment after that date.


Z31.4 Price adjustment Options

Each amount due includes an amount for price adjustment which is the sum of

- The change in the Price for Service Provided to Date since the last assessment of the amount due multiplied by the PAF and
- The amount for price adjustment included in the previous amount due
