1992 - Design and Construction of the S278 Works at Hethersett Lane, Norwich - Tender Amendment Nr. 2

Further to our letter dated 20 May 2020 enclosing the tender documents for the above project, please will you make the following amendments to your tender:

- a) Amey Drawings in PDF format showing the street lighting required to be installed under the Contract as per Appendix F – List of Drawings;
- b) Clarification on the extent of street lighting to be included in the Tender Submissions and the Contract;
 - i. Tenderers are to include within their price for the full street lighting works shown on the Amey drawings provided, including where these extend beyond the 'extent of works' labelled on the drawings and beyond the extent of any drawings previously issued.
- c) Revised Aecom drawings due to a change in horizontal alignment of The Works to be reviewed by Tenderers and incorporated into their Tender Submission as per Appendix F List of Drawings;
- d) Revised Appendix F List of Drawings Rev C due to this Tender Amendment Nr. 2;
- e) Tenderers are to note the following clarifications when compiling their Tender Submission;
 - i. Tenderers <u>must</u> complete and submit with their Tender the Suitability & Capability Assessment document included under Appendix P and the Qualitative Statements included under Appendix Q. Tenders will be adjudicated based on the quality and standard of the responses provided to these documents so it is vital that they are included in any Tender Returns.
 - Tenders will be deemed **non-compliant** if Appendix P and Appendix Q are not submitted with the tender return.
 - ii. Tenderers <u>must</u> allow in their price submission for new full-depth construction of the new roads. Any changes to the road construction after the Tender Return, including reduction in depth, regulating courses and the like, will be assessed as a value engineering exercise with the successful contractor.
 - iii. Due to the timescales associated with the project, the Client and their Design Team are progressing the Traffic Regulation Order matters directly including the payment of fees. As such, Tenderers are **not required** to allow any costs associated with the foregoing within their Submission.
 - iv. Please note that the successful Contractor <u>will be required</u> to arrange the Stage 3 Road Safety Audit with the adopting authority, with the audit and any subsequent works to be undertaken prior to Practical Completion.

- f) Revised letter, specification and cost estimate from BT Openreach under Appendix O Utilities, with all costs and time associated with delivering these works to be included in Tender Submissions;
- g) The Contractor is to note that the following amendments are to be made to the Employers Requirements / Contract Particulars by issuance of this Tender Addenda (Nr. 2);
 - Section C12.27 of the Employer's Requirements, to be amended to state that "Practical Completion cannot occur unless the Contractor has received the "Certificate of Substantial Completion" from the adopting authority."
 - ii. Section 7.3.1 of the Contract: Performance Bond particulars, to be amended as follows:
 - i. Period of Validity the date for issue of the Notice of Making Good Defects for the Works
 - ii. Reduction in Value 80%
