Does the council have any preferences on materials – whether that be for equipment or natural features within a design? Timber/steel/rope/HDPE etc A. No, we are open to any suggestions.

Any preferred safety surfacing for the council?

A. No, we are open to any suggestions.

Do we need to cost for site removals – such as the existing timber fort on top of the mound and slide and/or the large timber multi play system or will these be removal by others

A. Please cost removal by yourselves and make the cost clear in your bid The twin bay junior swings and outdoor fitness equipment looks and I believe to be fairly new to the site – are these to remain insitu and used within a new design?

A. The fitness equipment is outside of the children's play area so not included in this project. If it is more cost effective and fitting with the design then please reuse the swings, if they cannot be reused here we would most likely retain them for use at another site.

Age range and suitability – how should the budget be allocated?

A. The site currently caters for children under the age of around 10-12. We're not considered allocating the budget to any piece of equipment.

Accessibility and inclusivity – at present, existing equipment is situated on grass – fairly spread out across the site – within a new design, would the preference be grouping equipment/features and allowing them to have 'ease' of access for all ages and abilities – example being incorporating a path, linking to the play equipment?
