## **Clarification Questions and Responses**

- Q) The scoring matrix states the Financial Evaluation Factor represents 35% of the marks. Can the Council provide additional information re: how scores will be calculated in relation to bidders' respective bids? (e.g., cheapest scores full marks, 2<sup>nd</sup> cheapest scores...)
- A) This is more about the "Value for Money" aspect rather than the cheapest being given the best score so full marks could be given to more than one supplier.
- Q) Can the Council confirm all play items are to be removed / none are to be retained?
- A) All play equipment to be removed. Benches and bin to be retained.
- Q) Can the Council confirm its preferences in terms of desirable and nondesirable materials? (soft timber, hard timber, galvanised steel, HPL, HDPE...)
- A) Durability & Safety is more important here but steel with elements of hard timber / Robinia where appropriate.
- Q) Will the Council have a preference between stainless steel or plastic slides?
- A) Once again, durability and safety is primary so whichever is suitable.
- Q) Does the Council require a replacement flush in-ground roundabout?
- A) This will be dictated by the design but accessibility and inclusivity should be factored into the final design?
- Q) Does the Council have a preference between rubber mulch and wetpour?
- A) Once again durability and safety are key. Perhaps a combination if considered appropriate. grass to remain where possible outside of the equipment safety surface zones.

Just to clarify that a path is required between the gates (one relocated) as the parish council may consider extension of the path outside of the play area as a separate project in the future.
