



Royal Navy People and Training Transformation Market Interest Event

Tuesday 21st September 2021

Background

The Royal Navy People and Training Directorate (P&T) is responsible for the Navy's full employment cycle, from recruitment to exit, and the transformation of associated processes to ensure continued relevance to a modern workforce. P&T is exploring options to deliver a transformed people management capability to improve availability, exploit new technology, enhance productivity and improve the lived experience of sailors in the Royal Navy.

The Event

A Market Interest Event to set out the scope of the requirement will be held virtually from 1000 on Tuesday 21 September 2021.

The day will involve a presentation from the Royal Navy, a post event questionnaire and 1-to-1 forums to inform options available to the Royal Navy.

The session will provide potential suppliers and sub-contractors with:

- Background and detail on the project.
- The opportunity to speak to the Project Team and other RN stakeholders.
- The opportunity to ask questions in a 1-to-1 forum.
- The opportunity to further inform Royal Navy thinking.

The team are considering various commercial and business approaches to deliver the requirement and would welcome industry feedback.

Suppliers should limit the number of attendees at the presentation to 5 per company and the maximum for the one to one is 3 attendees.

The following are the core activities:

- Provision of service enabling technology to support HR Service Delivery (HRSD) and the Talent Programme
- Provision of technical expertise to support with the implementation of technology
- Support with change management across the People and Training portfolio.

The following activities may also be required:

- Programme leadership and governance support

Outputs from the Market Interest Event, including the post-event questionnaire, will be made available to all suppliers who registered an interest and/or attended and may be included as part of a prospective tender documentation pack. Therefore, no technical, financial, or commercially sensitive information should be included in any respective supplier's submission.

Supplier/Authority Sessions

Following the presentations, the Authority will host 1-to-1 sessions with any suppliers who wish to further discuss the requirement or offer any suggestions. Each session will last a maximum of 15 minutes. These will take place from 1200 on Tuesday 21 September but, depending on the number of requests, may also be held on subsequent days.
