SCHEDULE 2 - SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

41 Privacy and Data Protection

For the purposes of this Clause 41, unless the context indicates otherwise, the following expressions shall have the following meanings:

- “Authority Personal Data”** Personal Data and/or Sensitive Personal Data Processed by the Service Provider or any sub-contractor on behalf of the Authority, pursuant to or in connection with this Contract;
- “Data Controller”** has the meaning given to it in Data Protection Legislation;
- “Data Processor”** has the meaning given to it in Data Protection Legislation;
- “Data Protection Impact Assessment”** a process used to identify and mitigate the privacy and data protection risks associated with an activity involving the Processing of Personal Data;
- “Data Protection Legislation”** means:
- (a) any legislation in force from time to time in the United Kingdom which implements the European Community’s Directive 95/46/EC and Directive 2002/58/EC, including but not limited to the Data Protection Act 1998 and the Privacy and Electronic Communications (EC Directive) Regulations 2003;
 - (b) from 25 May 2018 only, the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the Processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data (the "**General Data Protection Regulation**");
 - (c) any other legislation in force from time to time in the United Kingdom relating to privacy and/or the Processing of Personal Data; and
 - (d) any statutory codes of practice issued by the Information Commissioner in relation to such legislation;

“Data Subject”	has the meaning given to it in Data Protection Legislation;
“Personal Data”	has the meaning given to it in Data Protection Legislation;
“Processing”	has the meaning given to it in Data Protection Legislation and “Process” and “Processed” will be construed accordingly;
“Restricted Countries”	any country outside the European Economic Area;
“Sensitive Personal Data”	sensitive or special categories of Personal Data (as defined in Data Protection Legislation) which is Processed pursuant to or in connection with this Contract; and
“Subject Access Request”	a request made by a Data Subject to access his or her own Personal Data in accordance with rights granted in Data Protection Legislation.

- 41.1 With respect to the Parties' rights and obligations under the Contract, the Parties acknowledge that the Authority is a Data Controller solely responsible for determining the purposes and manner in which Authority Personal Data is to be Processed, and that the Service Provider is a Data Processor.
- 41.2 Details of the Authority Personal Data to be processed by the Service Provider and the purposes of such Processing are as follows:
- 41.2.1 The Authority Personal Data to be Processed by the Service Provider (if any) concerns the following categories of Data Subject:
- Staff
- 41.2.2 The Authority Personal Data to be Processed includes the following types of Personal Data and/or Sensitive Personal Data:
- Name, Office Location, Office Telephone Number
- 41.2.3 The Authority Personal Data is to be Processed for the following purpose(s):
- Operation of the help desk and provision of responses to help desks requests.
- 41.3 Without prejudice to the generality of Clause 22, the Service Provider shall:
- 41.3.1 process the Authority Personal Data only in accordance with instructions from the Authority to perform its obligations under the Contract;

- 41.3.2 use its reasonable endeavours to assist the Authority in complying with any obligations under Data Protection Legislation and shall not perform its obligations under this Contract in such a way as to cause the Authority to breach any of its obligations under Data Protection Legislation to the extent the Service Provider is aware, or ought reasonably to have been aware, that the same would be a breach of such obligations;
- 41.3.3 notify the Authority without undue delay if it determines or is notified that an instruction to Process Personal Data issued to it by the Authority is incompatible with any obligations under Data Protection Legislation to the extent the Service Provider is aware, or ought reasonably to have been aware, that the same would be a breach of such obligations;
- 41.3.4 maintain, and make available to the Authority on its request, documentation which describes the Processing operations for which it is responsible under this Contract including:
- 41.3.4.1 the purposes for which Authority Personal Data is Processed;
 - 41.3.4.2 the types of Personal Data and categories of Data Subject involved;
 - 41.3.4.3 the source(s) of the Personal Data;
 - 41.3.4.4 any recipients of the Personal Data;
 - 41.3.4.5 the location(s) of any overseas Processing of Authority Personal Data;
 - 41.3.4.6 retention periods for different types of Authority Personal Data; and
 - 41.3.4.7 where possible a general description of the security measures in place to protect Authority Personal Data.
- 41.3.5 where requested to do so by the Authority, or where Processing Authority Personal Data presents a specific risk to privacy, carry out a Data Protection Impact Assessment in accordance with guidance issued from time to time by the Information Commissioner (and any relevant requirements detailed in Data Protection Legislation) and make the results of such an assessment available to the Authority;
- 41.3.6 without prejudice to any cyber security and/or payment card industry data security standard obligations in this Contract, take appropriate technical and organisational security measures that are satisfactory to the Authority from time to time, against unauthorised or unlawful Processing of Authority Personal Data and against accidental loss, destruction of, or damage to such Authority Personal Data;

- 41.3.7 without prejudice to any cyber security and/or payment card industry data security standard obligations in this Contract, provide the Authority with such information as the Authority may from time to time require to satisfy itself of compliance by the Service Provider (and/or any authorised sub-contractor) with Clauses 41.3.6 and 41.3.8, including, protocols, procedures, guidance, training and manuals. For the avoidance of doubt, this shall include a full report recording the results of any privacy or security audit carried out at the request of the Service Provider itself or the Authority;
- 41.3.8 notify the Authority without undue delay and in any event within 24 hours by written notice with all relevant details reasonably available of any actual or suspected breach of this Clause 41, including the unauthorised or unlawful Processing of Authority Personal Data, or its accidental loss, destruction or damage;
- 41.3.9 having notified the Authority of a breach in accordance with Clause 41.3.8, keep the Authority properly and regularly informed in writing until the breach has been resolved to the satisfaction of the Authority;
- 41.3.10 fully cooperate as the Authority requires with any investigation or audit in relation to Authority Personal Data and/or its Processing including allowing access to premises, computers and other information systems, records, documents and agreements as may be reasonably necessary (whether in relation to Processing pursuant to the Contract, in relation to compliance with Data Protection Legislation or in relation to any actual or suspected breach), whether by the Authority (or any agent acting on its behalf), any relevant regulatory body, including the Information Commissioner, the police and any other statutory law enforcement agency, and shall do so both during the Contract and after its termination or expiry (for so long as the Party concerned retains and/or Processes Authority Personal Data);
- 41.3.11 notify the Authority within two (2) Business Days if it, or any sub-contractor, receives:
- 41.3.11.1 from a Data Subject (or third party on their behalf):
 - 41.3.11.1.1 a Subject Access Request (or purported Subject Access Request);
 - 41.3.11.1.2 a request to rectify, block or erase any Authority Personal Data; or
 - 41.3.11.1.3 any other request, complaint or communication relating to the Authority's obligations under Data Protection Legislation.

- 41.3.11.2 any communication from the Information Commissioner or any other regulatory authority in connection with Authority Personal Data; or
- 41.3.11.3 a request from any third party for disclosure of Authority Personal Data where compliance with such request is required or purported to be required by law;
- 41.3.12 provide the Authority with full cooperation and assistance (within the timescales reasonably required by the Authority) in relation to any complaint, communication or request made as referred to in Clause 41.3.11, including by promptly providing:
 - 41.3.12.1 the Authority with full details and copies of the complaint, communication or request;
 - 41.3.12.2 where applicable, such assistance as is reasonably requested by the Authority to enable it to comply with the Subject Access Request within the relevant timescales set out in Data Protection Legislation; and
 - 41.3.12.3 where applicable, such assistance as is reasonably required by the Authority to enable it to comply with a request from a Data Subject to rectify, block or erase any Authority Personal Data.
- 41.3.13 when notified in writing by the Authority, supply a copy of, or information about, any Authority Personal Data. The Service Provider shall supply such information or data to the Authority within such time and in such form as specified in the request (such time to be reasonable) or if no period of time is specified in the request, then within two (2) Business Days from the date of the request;
- 41.3.14 when notified in writing by the Authority, comply with any agreement between the Authority and any Data Subject in relation to any Processing which causes or is likely to cause substantial and unwarranted damage or distress to such Data Subject, or any court order requiring the rectification, blocking, erasure or destruction of any Authority Personal Data; and
- 41.3.15 if required to do so by Data Protection Legislation, appoint a designated Data Protection Officer.
- 41.4 The Service Provider shall not share Authority Personal Data with any sub-contractor without prior written consent from the Authority and only where there is a written contract in place between the Service Provider and the sub-contractor which requires the sub-contractor to:
 - 41.4.1 only Process Authority Personal Data in accordance with the Authority's instructions to the Service Provider; and

- 41.4.2 comply with the same obligations which the Service Provider is required to comply with under this Clause 41 (and in particular Clauses 12.1, 16.1, 16.2, 18.1, 20.2, 22 and 23).
- 41.5 The Service Provider shall, and shall procure that any sub-contractor shall:
 - 41.5.1 only Process Authority Personal Data in accordance with the Authority's instructions to the Service Provider and as reasonably necessary to perform the Contract in accordance with its terms;
 - 41.5.2 not Process Authority Personal Data for any other purposes (in whole or part) and specifically, but without limitation, reproduce or refer to it in training materials, training courses, commercial discussions and negotiations with third parties or in relation to proposals or tenders with the Authority;
 - 41.5.3 not Process Authority Personal Data in such a way as to:
 - 41.5.3.1 place the Authority in breach of Data Protection Legislation;
 - 41.5.3.2 expose the Authority to the risk of actual or potential liability to the Information Commissioner or Data Subjects;
 - 41.5.3.3 expose the Authority to reputational damage including adverse publicity;
 - 41.5.4 not allow Service Provider's Personnel to access Authority Personal Data unless such access is necessary in connection with the provision of the Services;
 - 41.5.5 take all reasonable steps to ensure the reliability and integrity of all Service Provider's Personnel who can access Authority Personal Data;
 - 41.5.6 ensure that all Service Provider's Personnel who can access Authority Personal Data:
 - 41.5.6.1 are informed of its confidential nature;
 - 41.5.6.2 are made subject to an explicit duty of confidence;
 - 41.5.6.3 understand and comply with any relevant obligations created by either this Contract or Data Protection Legislation; and
 - 41.5.6.4 receive adequate training in relation to the use, care, protection and handling of Personal Data on an annual basis.
 - 41.5.7 not disclose or transfer Authority Personal Data to any third party without the Service Provider having obtained the prior written

consent of the Authority (save where such disclosure or transfer is specifically authorised under this Contract);

- 41.5.8 without prejudice to Clause 41.3.6, wherever the Service Provider uses any mobile or portable device for the transmission or storage of Authority Personal Data, ensure that each such device encrypts Authority Personal Data; and
- 41.5.9 comply during the course of the Contract with any written retention and/or deletion policy or schedule provided by the Authority to the Service Provider from time to time.
- 41.6 The Service Provider shall not, and shall procure that any sub-contractor shall not, Process or otherwise transfer any Authority Personal Data in or to any Restricted Countries without prior written consent from the Authority (which consent may be subject to additional conditions imposed by the Authority).
- 41.7 If, after the Service Commencement Date, the Service Provider or any sub-contractor wishes to Process and/or transfer any Authority Personal Data in or to any Restricted Countries, the following provisions shall apply:
 - 41.7.1 the Service Provider shall submit a written request to the Authority setting out details of the following:
 - 41.7.1.1 the Authority Personal Data which will be transferred to and/or Processed in any Restricted Countries;
 - 41.7.1.2 the Restricted Countries which the Authority Personal Data will be transferred to and/or Processed in;
 - 41.7.1.3 any sub-contractors or other third parties who will be Processing and/or receiving Authority Personal Data in Restricted Countries;
 - 41.7.1.4 how the Service Provider shall ensure an adequate level of protection and adequate safeguards in respect of the Authority Personal Data that will be Processed in and/or transferred to Restricted Countries so as to ensure the Authority's compliance with Data Protection Legislation;
 - 41.7.2 in preparing and evaluating such a request, the Parties shall refer to and comply with applicable policies, procedures, guidance and codes of practice produced by the Parties and/or the Information Commissioner in connection with the Processing of Personal Data in (and/or transfer of Personal Data to) any Restricted Countries;
 - 41.7.3 the Service Provider shall comply with any instructions and shall carry out such actions as the Authority may notify in writing when providing its consent to such Processing or transfers, including:
 - 41.7.3.1 incorporating standard and/or model clauses (which are approved by the European Commission as

offering adequate safeguards under the Data Protection Legislation) into this Contract or a separate data processing agreement between the Parties; and

41.7.3.2 procuring that any sub-contractor or other third party who will be Processing and/or receiving or accessing the Authority Personal Data in any Restricted Countries enters into a data processing agreement with the Service Provider on terms which are equivalent to those agreed between the Authority and the Service Provider in connection with the Processing of Authority Personal Data in (and/or transfer of Authority Personal Data to) any Restricted Countries, and which may include the incorporation of the clauses referred to in 41.7.3.1.

41.8 The Service Provider and any sub-contractor (if any), acknowledge:

41.8.1 the importance to Data Subjects and the Authority of safeguarding Authority Personal Data and Processing it only in accordance with the Authority's instructions and the Contract;

41.8.2 the loss and damage the Authority is likely to suffer in the event of a breach of the Contract or negligence in relation to Authority Personal Data;

41.8.3 any breach of any obligation in relation to Authority Personal Data and/or negligence in relation to performance or non performance of such obligation shall be deemed a material breach of Contract;

41.8.4 notwithstanding Clause 26.1.1, if the Service Provider has committed a material breach under Clause 41.8.3 on two or more separate occasions, the Authority may at its option:

41.8.4.1 exercise its step in rights pursuant to Clause 416;

41.8.4.1 withdraw authorisation for Processing by a specific sub-contractor by immediate written notice; or

41.8.4.2 terminate the Contract in whole or part with immediate written notice to the Service Provider.

41.9 Compliance by the Service Provider with this Clause 41 shall be without additional charge to the Authority.

41.10 Following termination or expiry of this Contract, howsoever arising, the Service Provider:

41.10.1 may Process the Authority Personal Data only for so long and to the extent as is necessary to properly comply with its non-contractual obligations arising under law (and will then comply with Clause 41.10.2);

41.10.2 subject to Clause 41.10.1, shall;

41.10.2.1 on written instructions from the Authority either securely destroy or securely and promptly return to the Authority or a recipient nominated by the Authority (in such usable format as and to the extent the Authority may reasonably require) the Authority Personal Data; or

A.10.2.2 in the absence of instructions from the Authority after 12 months from the expiry or termination of the Contract securely destroy the Authority Personal Data.

41.11 Authority Personal Data may not be Processed following termination or expiry of the Contract save as permitted by Clause 41.10.

41.12 For the avoidance of doubt, and without prejudice to Clause 41.10, the obligations in this Clause 41 shall apply following termination or expiry of the Contract to the extent the Party concerned retains or Processes Authority Personal Data.

41.13 The indemnity in Clause 18 shall apply to any breach of Clause 41 and shall survive termination or expiry of the Contract.

41.14 The Parties' liability in respect of any breach of Clause 22.1 and this Clause 41 insofar as they relate to fines, court awards, settlements and legal costs shall be unlimited.

42 Step-in

42.1 If the Authority reasonably believes that it needs to take action in connection with the Services:

42.1.1 because a serious risk exists to the health or safety of persons or property or to the environment; and/or

42.1.2 to discharge a statutory duty,

then the following provisions shall apply.

42.2 The Authority shall provide notice to the Service Provider in writing of the following:

42.2.1 the action it wishes to take;

42.2.2 the reason for such action;

42.2.3 the date it wishes to commence such action;

42.2.4 the time period which it believes will be necessary for such action; and

- 42.2.5 to the extent practicable, the effect on the Service Provider and its obligations to provide the Services during the period such action is being taken.
- 42.3 Following service of the notice required in Clause 42.2, the Authority or a third party appointed by the Authority for the purpose shall take such action as is notified under these provisions and any consequential additional action as the Authority reasonably believes is necessary (the “**Required Action**”) and the Service Provider shall give all reasonable assistance to the Authority or such third party while it is taking such Required Action (such assistance to be at the expense of the Authority).
- 42.4 For so long as and to the extent that the Required Action is taken, and this prevents the Service Provider from providing any part of the Services, the Service Provider shall be relieved from its obligations to provide such part of the Services and the Authority shall not be liable to pay Charges for such part of the Services (except to the extent that the Authority shall pay the Service Provider for the assistance it provides in accordance with Clause 42.3).

45 London Living Wage

For the purposes of this Clause 45, unless the context indicates otherwise, the expression “**London Living Wage**” means a basic hourly wage as updated from time to time by the GLA Economics Unit or any relevant replacement organisation and as notified to the Service Provider.

- 45.1 The Service Provider acknowledges and agrees that the Mayor of London pursuant to section 155 of the GLA Act has directed that members of the Authority Group ensure that the London Living Wage is paid to anyone engaged by any member of the Authority Group who is required to discharge contractual obligations in Greater London or on the Authority’s estate.
- 45.2 Without prejudice to any other provision of this Contract, the Service Provider shall:
- 45.2.1 ensure that none of its employees engaged in the provision of the Services (in Greater London or on the Authority’s estate but not otherwise) is paid an hourly wage (or equivalent of an hourly wage) less than the London Living Wage;
- 45.2.3 ensure that none of its employees engaged in the provision of the Services is paid less than the amount to which they are entitled in their respective contracts of employment;

- 45.2.4 provide to the Authority such information concerning the London Living Wage and as the Authority or its nominees may reasonably require from time to time;
 - 45.2.5 disseminate on behalf of the Authority to its employees engaged in the provision of the Services such perception questionnaires as the Authority may reasonably require from time to time and promptly collate and return to the Authority responses to such questionnaires; and
 - 45.2.5 co-operate and provide all reasonable assistance in monitoring the effect of the London Living Wage.
- 45.3 For the avoidance of doubt the Service Provider shall implement any updated London Living Wage on or before 1 April in the year following notification of such updated London Living Wage.
- 45.4 The Authority reserves the right to audit (acting by itself or its nominee(s)) the provision of the London Living Wage to the Service Provider's staff and the staff of its sub-contractors.
- 45.5 Any breach by the Service Provider of the provisions of this Clause 45 shall be treated as a material breach capable of remedy in accordance with Clause 26.1.1.

46 Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment Regulations 2013

- 47.1 For the purposes of this Clause 46, unless the context indicates otherwise, the following expressions shall have the following meanings:

“WEE Equipment” means any Equipment which falls within the scope of the WEEE Regulations; and

“WEEE Regulations” means Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment Regulations 2013 (as amended by the Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment and Restriction on the Use of Certain Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment (Amendment) Regulations 2014 and the Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (Amendment) Regulations 2015.

- 46.2 When procuring any WEE Equipment for use in accordance with the Services whether by direct purchase by the Service Provider, purchase on behalf of the Authority, lease or otherwise the Service Provider will ensure that in accordance with the WEEE Regulations that the producer of the WEE Equipment (whether that be the Service Provider or a third party) shall assume responsibility for financing the costs of the collection, treatment, recovery and environmentally sound disposal of:

- (a) all Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment arising from the WEE Equipment; and
- (b) all Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment arising from equipment placed on the market prior to 13 August 2005 where such equipment is to be replaced by the WEEE Equipment and the WEEE Equipment is of an equivalent type or is fulfilling the same function as the equipment.

46.3 The Service Provider shall indemnify and keep indemnified the Authority as a result of any Losses which it incurs as a result of any failure on the part of the Authority or the relevant producer to comply with the terms of this Clause 46.

47 Supplier Diversity

47.1 Compliance

47.1.1 Without limiting the generality of any other provision of this Contract, the Service Provider:

- (a) shall not unlawfully discriminate,
- (b) shall procure that its personnel do not unlawfully discriminate, and
- (c) shall use reasonable endeavours to procure that its direct and indirect subcontractors do not unlawfully discriminate in relation to the Services,

within the meaning and scope of the Equality Act 2010 and any other relevant enactments in force from time to time relating to discrimination in employment.

47.1.2 The Service Provider acknowledges that the Authority as a public authority is subject to a statutory duty under section 149 of the Equality Act 2010 to have due regard to the need to eliminate unlawful discrimination on the grounds of sex, marital or civil partnership status, race, sexual orientation, religion or belief, age, pregnancy or maternity, gender reassignment or disability (a “**Relevant Protected Characteristic**”) (as the case may be) and to promote equality of opportunity between persons who share a Relevant Protected Characteristic and persons who do not share it. In providing the Services, the Service Provider shall assist and cooperate with Authority where possible in satisfying this duty.

47.1.3 Where possible, the Service Provider shall provide the Services in such a manner as to:

- (a) promote equality of opportunity for all persons irrespective of their race, sex, disability, age, sexual orientation or religion;
- (b) eliminate unlawful discrimination; and
- (c) promote good relations between persons of different racial groups, religious beliefs and sexual orientation.

47.1.4 The Authority's Harassment, Bullying and Discrimination Policy ("**Policy**") as up-dated from time to time (copies of which are available on request from the Authority) requires the Authority's own staff and those of its direct and indirect subcontractors to comply fully with the Policy to eradicate harassment in the workplace. The Service Provider shall:

- (a) ensure that its staff, and those of its direct and indirect subcontractors who are engaged in the performance of the Contract are fully conversant with the requirements of the Policy;
- (b) fully investigate allegations of workplace harassment in accordance with the Policy; and
- (c) ensure that appropriate, effective action is taken where harassment is found to have occurred.

47.2 Strategic Equality & Diversity Plan

47.2.1 For the duration of this Contract, the Service Provider shall comply with the Agreed Strategic Equality & Diversity Plan and shall procure that each of its direct subcontractors:

- (a) adopts and implements; and
- (b) in respect of other tiers of subcontractors beneath the Service Provider's direct subcontractors uses reasonable endeavours to procure that those indirect subcontractors adopt and implement,

a strategic equality and diversity plan in respect of their respective employees engaged in the performance of the Contract which is at least as extensive in scope as that agreed with the Authority and set out in the Agreed Strategic Equality & Diversity Plan.

For the purposes of this Agreement the expression "**Agreed Strategic Equality & Diversity Plan**" means the strategic equality & diversity plan as negotiated and agreed and attached to the Contract as a Schedule headed "Agreed Strategic Equality & Diversity Plan".

47.2.2 Where a subcontractor has, pursuant to Clause 47.2 or otherwise, adopted a Strategic Equality & Diversity Plan, the Service Provider shall procure that each of its direct subcontractors:

- (a) provides; and
- (b) in respect of other tiers of subcontractors beneath the Service Provider's direct subcontractors, use reasonable endeavours to procure that those indirect subcontractors provide,

a copy of its Strategic Equality & Diversity Plan (and any amendments thereto) to the Authority or its nominee as soon as reasonably practicable.

47.3 Diversity Training

47.3.1 For the duration of this Contract, the Service Provider shall comply with the Agreed Training Plan in relation to all of its employees engaged in the performance of the Contract. For the purposes of this Contract the expression "**Agreed Training Plan**" means the diversity training plan set out as agreed and attached to the Contract as a Schedule headed "Agreed Training Plan". The Service Provider shall procure that each of its direct subcontractors:

- (a) adopts and implements; and
- (b) in respect of other tiers of subcontractors beneath the Service Provider's direct subcontractors uses reasonable endeavours to procure that those indirect subcontractors adopt and implement,

a diversity training plan in respect of their respective employees engaged in the performance of the Contract which is at least as extensive in scope as the Agreed Training Plan.

47.3.2 Where a subcontractor has, pursuant to Clause 47.1 or otherwise, adopted a diversity training plan, the Service Provider shall procure that each of its direct subcontractors:

- (a) provides; and
- (b) in respect of other tiers of subcontractors beneath the Service Provider's direct subcontractors, use reasonable endeavours to procure that those indirect subcontractors provide,

a copy of its diversity training plan (and any amendments thereto) to the Authority or its nominee as soon as reasonably practicable.

47.4 Supplier Diversity

47.4.1 For the duration of this Contract the Service Provider shall at all times comply with the Agreed Supplier Diversity Plan. For the purposes of this Contract the expression "**Agreed Supplier Diversity Plan**" means the supplier diversity plan set out as agreed and attached to the Contract as a Schedule headed "Agreed Supplier Diversity Plan". The Service Provider shall procure that each of its direct subcontractors:

- (a) adopts and implements; and
- (b) in respect of other tiers of subcontractors beneath the Service Provider's direct subcontractors uses reasonable endeavours to procure that those indirect subcontractors adopt and implement,

a supplier diversity plan in relation to the performance of this Contract which is as least as extensive as the Agreed Supplier Diversity Plan.

47.4.2 Where a subcontractor has, pursuant to Clause 47.4.1 or otherwise, adopted a supplier diversity plan, the Service Provider shall procure that each of its direct subcontractors:

- (a) provides; and
- (b) in respect of other tiers of subcontractors beneath the Service Provider's direct subcontractors, use reasonable endeavours to procure that those indirect subcontractors provide;

a copy of its supplier diversity plan (and any amendments thereto) to the Authority or its nominee as soon as reasonably practicable.

47.5 Communications Plan

47.5.1 For the duration of this Contract and in all dealings with the Local Community, the Service Provider shall comply with the Agreed Communications Plan. For the purposes of this Contract the expression "**Agreed Communications Plan**" means the communications plan agreed and attached to the Contract as a Schedule headed "Agreed Communication Plan" and the expression "**Local Community**" means those areas of London affected by the Works from time to time.

47.6 Monitoring and Reporting

47.6.1 Subject to Clause 47.6.2, the Service Provider shall use reasonable endeavours to provide the Authority on the date of this Contract and subsequently every 12 months from the date or such other frequency as the Authority may reasonably request of this Contract with the following information:

An annual report on performance and compliance with the equality and diversity provisions as set out in clauses 47.2 to 47.5. The annual report should set out:

- (a) the performance of the Service Provider over the past 12 months in relation to the Agreed Strategic Equality and Diversity Plan, the Agreed Training Plan, the Agreed Supplier Diversity Plan and the Agreed Communications Plan and/or the action plan submitted for the previous 12 months in accordance with clause 47.6.1(d);
- (b) the proportion of its employees engaged in the performance of the Contract and, to the extent reasonably possible, the employees of its direct or indirect subcontractors engaged pursuant to the terms of the relevant subcontracts in the performance of the Contract who are:
 - (i) female;
 - (ii) of non-white British origin or who classify themselves as being non-white British;
 - (iii) from the Local Community;
 - (iv) disabled;

- (c) the proportion of its direct or indirect subcontractors that are SMEs and/or BAMEs and/or other suppliers from other under-represented or protected groups; and
- (d) a plan of action for the forthcoming 12 months showing what the Service Provider plans to do to continue delivery of the equality & supplier diversity objectives.

For the purposes of this clause, the meaning of “**SME**” and “**BAME**” is as set out in the attached document called TfL Supplier Diversity Definitions.

47.6.2 The Service Provider shall ensure at all times that it complies with the requirements of the Data Protection Act 1998 (as may be amended) in the collection and reporting of the information to the Authority pursuant to clause 47.6.1.

47.7 Equality and Diversity Infractions

47.7.1 If the Service Provider or any of its direct subcontractors commits a Equality & Diversity Infraction, the Authority shall be entitled (but not obliged) to act as follows:

- (a) if a Equality & Diversity Infraction is committed by the Service Provider then the Authority may serve written notice upon the Contractor identifying in reasonable detail the nature of the Equality & Diversity Infraction, and the Service Provider shall cease committing and remedy, at its own cost, the Equality & Diversity Infraction, within 30 days of receipt of such notice (or such longer period as may be specified in the notice); or
- (b) if the Equality & Diversity Infraction is committed by a direct subcontractor of the Service Provider, the Authority may serve written notice upon the Service Provider identifying in reasonable detail the nature of the Equality & Diversity Infraction, and the Service Provider shall procure that the direct subcontractor ceases committing and remedies, at its own cost, the Equality & Diversity Infraction within 30 days of receipt by the Service Provider of such notice (or such longer period as may be specified in the notice). If the Service Provider fails to procure the remedy of the Equality & Diversity Infraction, the Authority may serve a further written notice upon the Service Provider and within 30 days of receipt of such further notice (or such longer period as may be specified in the notice), the Service Provider shall terminate, at its own cost, the relevant contract with its direct subcontractor and procure performance of the affected works or services by another person which also complies with the obligations specified in clauses 47.2 to 47.5 of this Contract.

47.7.2 It shall be a fundamental term and condition of the Contract that the Service Provider complies with its obligations under clauses 47.7.1(a) to 47.7.1(b). Where, following receipt of a notice given pursuant to clause 47.7.1(a) or 47.7.1(b) the Service Provider fails to remedy an Equality & Diversity Infraction to the satisfaction of the Authority or in the case of clause 47.7.1(b)

- fails to terminate the contract with a defaulting subcontractor and procure performance by another person on the terms specified in clause 47.7.1(b) the Service Provider will be in breach of the Contract and the Authority shall be entitled (but not obliged) to terminate the Contract, without further notice to the Service Provider, in accordance with the termination clause in this Contract.
- 47.7.3 For the purposes of this clause 47.7 **"Equality & Diversity Infraction"** means any breach by the Service Provider of its obligations specified in clauses 47.2 to 47.5 of this Contract and/or any failure by a direct subcontractor to adopt and implement a strategic equality and diversity plan, a diversity training plan and/or a supplier diversity plan as described in clauses 47.2 to 47.5 of this Contract.
- 47.8 Equality and Diversity Audit
- 47.8.1 The Authority or its nominee may from time to time undertake any audit or check of any and all information regarding the Service Provider's compliance with clauses 47.2 to 47.5.
- 47.8.2 The Authority's rights pursuant to this clause shall include any and all documents and records of the Service Provider and its direct contractors and, where applicable, subject to the provisions of clauses 47.2 to 47.4 indirect subcontractors and shall include the Minimum Records.
- 47.8.3 The Service Provider shall, maintain and retain the Minimum Records for a minimum of six years from the termination or expiry of the Contract with respect to all matters in respect of the performance of and compliance with clauses 47.2 to 47.5. The Service Provider shall procure that each of its direct and, where applicable subject to the provisions of clauses 47.2 to 47.4, indirect subcontractors shall, maintain and retain the Minimum Records for a minimum of six years from the termination or expiry of the Contract with respect to all matters in respect of the performance of and compliance with clauses 47.2 to 47.4. The Service Provider shall procure that each subcontract between it and its direct subcontractors and, where applicable, subject to the provisions of clauses 47.2 to 47.4 each subcontract between its direct subcontractor and any indirect subcontractor of the Service Provider shall contain rights of audit in favour of and enforceable by the Authority substantially equivalent to those granted by the Service Provider pursuant to clause 47.8.
- 47.8.4 The Authority shall use reasonable endeavours to co-ordinate its audits and to manage the number, scope, timing and method of undertaking audits so as to ensure that the Service Provider and each direct subcontractor is not, without due cause, disrupted or delayed in the performance of its obligations under the Contract and/or relevant subcontract (as the case may be).
- 47.8.5 The Service Provider shall promptly provide, and procure that its direct subcontractors and, where applicable subject to the provisions of clauses 47.2 to 47.4 indirect subcontractors promptly provide all reasonable co-operation in relation to any audit or check including, to the extent reasonably possible in each particular circumstance:

- (a) granting or procuring the grant of access to any premises used in the Service Provider's performance of the Contract or in the relevant subcontractor's performance of its subcontract, whether the Service Provider's own premises or otherwise;
- (b) granting or procuring the grant of access to any equipment (including all computer hardware and software and databases) used (whether exclusively or non-exclusively) in the performance of the Service Provider's or the relevant subcontractor's obligations specified in clauses 47.2 to 47.4 wherever situated and whether the Service Provider's own equipment or otherwise; and
- (c) complying with the Authority's reasonable requests for access to senior personnel engaged in the Service Provider's performance of the Contract or the relevant subcontractor's performance of its subcontract.

47.8.6 For the purposes of this clause 47.8 the expression Minimum Records means all information relating to the Service Provider's performance of and compliance with clauses 47.2 to 47.5 and the adoption and implementation of a strategic equality and diversity plan, an equality & diversity training plan and a supplier diversity plan by each direct and, where applicable, subject to the provisions of clauses 47.2 to 47.4 indirect subcontractor of the Service Provider.

These definitions form a basis for the TfL Supplier Diversity Policy and act as a basis for alignment in the measurement of diverse suppliers.

2. **Diverse Suppliers**

For the purposes of TfL's Procurement Supplier Diversity Programme, "**Diverse Suppliers**" comprise the following four subsets:

2.1 Small and Medium Enterprises (SMEs)

2.2 Black, Asian and Minority Ethnic (BAME) businesses

2.3 Suppliers from other under-represented or protected groups

2.4 Suppliers demonstrating a diverse workforce composition

The more detailed explanations of the four above subsets are given in the sections below.

3. **Small and Medium Enterprises (SMEs)**

3.1 A Small Enterprise⁵ is a business which has both the following:

- i) 0-49 Full Time Equivalent employees¹;
- AND EITHER
- ii) Turnover² per annum of no more than £5.6 million net (or £6.72 million gross); in the last financial year;
- OR
- iii) Balance sheet total⁴ of no more than £2.8 million net (£3.36 million gross).

3.2 A Medium Enterprise⁵ is a business which has both the following:

- i) 50-249 Full Time Equivalent employees¹;
- AND EITHER
- ii) Turnover² per annum of no more than £22.8 million net (or £27.36 million gross) in the last financial year;
- OR
- iii) Balance sheet total⁴ of no more than £11.4 million net (or £13.68 million gross).

3.3 A Large Enterprise⁵ is a business which has both the following:

- i) 250 and over Full Time Equivalent employees¹;
- AND EITHER
- ii) Turnover² per annum over £22.8 million net (or £27.36 million gross) in the last financial year;
- OR
- iii) Balance sheet total⁴ of over £11.4 million net (or £13.68 gross).

¹ Full Time equivalent employees is defined in Section 7.1

² Turnover is defined in Section 7.3

⁴ Balance Sheet Total is defined in Section 7.5

⁵ Further explanation is outlined in Section 7.7 (Definition of Size) & 7.8 (Ownership Categorisation)

4. **Black, Asian and Minority Ethnic (BAME) owned businesses**

A Black, Asian and Minority Ethnic (BAME) owned business is a business which is 51% or more owned by members of one or more Black, Asian or Minority ethnic groups.

Minority ethnic groups are all people including those who have classified themselves as members of ethnic groups other than 'White British'.

The minority ethnic classification groups used by TfL for monitoring purposes are:

5. *Suppliers from other under-represented groups or protected groups*

5.1 A Supplier from an under-represented group is one which is 51% or more owned by members of one or more of the following groups (where not covered by previous definitions):

5.1.1 Women (gender)

5.1.2 Disabled people with physical and sensory impairments, learning difficulties and mental health requirements;

5.1.3 Lesbians, Gay men, Bisexual and Transgender people (sexual orientation); and

5.1.4 Older people (aged 60 or over), young people (aged 24 or under) (age)

5.2 A Supplier from a protected group is one which is 51% or more owned by members of a group for which protection is provided by anti-discriminatory legislation and which is not already covered by the above (such as religious, faith or belief groups, or alternatively, ownership by a social enterprise or a voluntary/community organisation).

6. *Suppliers demonstrating a diverse workforce composition*

This relates to Full Time Equivalent employees in the supplier's workforce who may be from one or more minority ethnic groups, and/or under-represented groups and/or protected groups as listed in II and III above.

7. *Other Definitions & Information*

7.1 Full-Time Equivalent Employees

Where employee numbers are used, these refer to Full-Time Equivalents (FTEs) expressed in **Annual Work Units** (see below). Staff headcount should include full-time, part-time and seasonal staff and includes the following:

- Employees
- Persons working for the enterprise being subordinated to it and considered to be employees under national law
- Owner managers
- Partners engaged in regular activity in the enterprise and benefiting from financial advantages from the enterprise.

Full-time workers are expressed as hours worked per week. TfL refer to standard UK hours of work as full time workers – i.e. those who work 35 hours a week and 52 weeks a year (including annual leave).

7.2 Annual Work Units

Refer to anyone who worked, over the past year, full-time within your enterprise, or on its behalf, during the entire reference year counts as one unit. You treat part-time staff, seasonal workers and those who did not work the full year as fractions of one unit.

7.3 Turnover

Turnover is in line with that defined in the Companies Act 1985:

The amounts derived from the provision of goods and services falling within the company's ordinary activities, after deduction of:

- i) trade discounts
- ii) value added tax

Please refer to Section 7.8 regarding ownership categorisation to understand how to interpret ownership, where an enterprise is part of a parent organisation.

7.4 Financial Year

Financial Year relates to 1st April – 31st March or any other 12 month period as defined by the company.

All data must be relating to the last approved accounting period and calculated on an annual basis. In the case of newly-established enterprises whose accounts have not yet been approved, the data to apply shall be derived from a reliable estimate made in the course of the financial year.

7.5 Balance Sheet Total

The annual balance sheet total refers to the value of your company's main assets.

7.6 Ownership

Individual or those in named control holding capital or voting rights - either through private or shared ownership - of any given business entity.

7.7 Definition of Size

Where headcount and turnover and/or balance sheet conditions apply to different size definitions, headcount acts as the more predominant aspect, in defining size.

An organisation does not need to satisfy both turnover and balance sheet total, only one of the conditions and may exceed one of them without losing its status. This is illustrated by an organisation which has 30 employees, a turnover of £12 million and a balance sheet total of £10 million. The number of employees figure would class the organisation as a small organisation, however the turnover and balance sheet total define the organisation as medium. In this case, the headcount would be used to define the classification of the organisation. This organisation would be classed as a small organisation.

To illustrate this, the following scenarios have been mapped for the different characteristics of supplier diversity definitions (based on information from the Department for Trade & Industry (*now Department for Business Enterprise & Regulatory Reform*)):

7.8 Ownership Categorisation

EU Commission Definition on Enterprise Ownership Categorisation

The European Commission's Guidance published in 2005 "The New SME Definition: User Guide and Model Declaration"⁶, outlines parameters for defining an organisation's ownership categorisation and whether an organisation is autonomous, partner or linked.

7.8.1 Autonomous

This is the most common category of ownership.

An organisation is autonomous if:

- It is totally independent, i.e. there is no participation in other enterprises and no enterprise has a participation.
- It has a holding of less than 25% of the capital or voting rights (whichever is the higher) in one or more other enterprises and/or outsiders do not have a stake of 25% or more of the capital or voting rights (whichever is the higher) in your enterprise.

If an organisation is autonomous, it means that it is not a partner or linked to another enterprise

7.8.2 Partner

An enterprise is a partner enterprise if:

- It has a holding equal to or greater than 25%, of the capital or voting rights in another enterprise and/or another enterprise has a holding equal to or greater than 25% in the other.

It is not linked to another enterprise. This means, among other things, that voting rights in the other enterprise (or vice versa) do not exceed 50%.

7.8.3 Linked

Enterprises formed as a **group** through the direct or indirect control of the majority of voting rights. An enterprise owned by another or through the ability to exercise a **dominant influence** on another enterprise.

Two or more enterprises are linked when they have any of the following relationships:

- One enterprise holds a majority of the shareholders' or members' voting rights in another.
- One enterprise is entitled to appoint or remove a majority of the administrative, management or supervisory body of another.
- A contract between the enterprises, or a provision in the memorandum or articles of association of one of the enterprises, enables one to exercise a dominant influence over the other.
- One enterprise is able, by agreement, to exercise sole control over a majority of shareholders' or members' voting rights in another.

1 SCOPE

1.1 General Scope of Services

The scope of services is planned and reactive catering equipment maintenance and delivery of associated services.

1.2 Nature of the Sites in Scope

The Sites include but are not limited to:

- Offices;
- Training Centres;
- Underground Stations;
- Underground Depots;
- Trackside accommodation;
- Operational accommodation

1.3 TfL Business Areas and Delivery Units in Scope

The TfL Business Areas and/or Delivery Units covered under this specification are as follows:

- TfL Head Offices;
- London Underground Ltd;
 - Stations
 - Depots; Trackside and Operational Accommodation

2 GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

2.1 Account Management Team

- 2.1.1 The Service Provider shall provide a team of suitably qualified and experienced personnel able to deliver a cost effective service that meets the specified quality standards (the "Account Management Team"). The Account Management Team structure including roles and responsibilities is subject to agreement by the Authority.
- 2.1.2 The Service Provider shall provide a level of personnel supervision appropriate to the risk at all times for all Service Provider personnel engaged in delivery of the Services.
- 2.1.3 The Service Provider's representatives shall be available and contactable 24 hours per day, seven days a week, every day of the year.
- 2.1.4 The Authority's contract management structure and reporting requirements are detailed in Schedule 10.

2.2 Security Vetting

- 2.2.1 Service Provider personnel requiring access to certain parts of the Sites shall be subject to security checks including but not limited to Metropolitan Police Service and British Transport Police clearance. Any such Sites where security checks are required, Service Provider personnel shall undergo a clearance procedure before working in these areas. Service Provider personnel without security clearance shall be escorted at all times by a member of the Service Provider's personnel who is security cleared and then only if the individual under supervision has a security clearance application submitted and pending. Any such supervision required will be provided at the Service Provider's cost.
- 2.2.2 The Service Provider shall provide sufficient numbers of security cleared personnel to deliver the Services without disruption.
- 2.2.3 The Service Provider shall provide details of security cleared personnel to the Authority and shall keep full records of all clearances and rejected clearances.

2.3 Security Passes

- 2.3.1 Service Provider personnel shall be in possession of a relevant security pass and/or Service Provider pass at all times when on the Sites. Where the Authority does not provide such passes to the Service Provider's personnel, the Service Provider shall implement its own security pass arrangements that shall be approved by the Authority in advance. As a minimum the Service Provider provided security pass shall include the personnel member's name, photograph and an expiry date. This requirement does not replace and is in addition to any specific Authority entry permits issued as part of a training course, which may be required for certain Sites.

2.4 Keys and Access

- 2.4.1 When required, keys and access cards (including other methods of controlled access) shall be provided to the Service Provider and the Service Provider shall be responsible for the safe keeping of such keys and access cards. The Service Provider shall not manufacture duplicate keys and access cards under any circumstances. The Service Provider shall return to the Authority all keys and access cards that have been issued on completion of any specific section of works for which keys and access cards have been issued. Please see Appendix N for all Work Access Procedures.
- 2.4.2 Should the Service Provider lose any key or access card provided by the Authority then immediately on discovery of the loss, the Service Provider shall:-
- a) notify the Authority of the loss; and
 - b) pay to the Authority the cost of replacement of the key(s) or card(s) including any associated installation work.

2.5 Appearance, Dress Code and Behaviour

- 2.5.1 The Service Provider shall ensure that all personnel engaged in the delivery of the Services shall be of good character, capability, appearance and behaviour. Service Provider personnel shall undertake the Services with a high level of awareness of customer safety.
- 2.5.2 The Service Provider shall ensure their personnel maintains the highest standard of appearance and behaviour at all times and are professional and courteous when dealing with customers, Authority personnel and visitors.
- 2.5.3 Service Provider personnel engaged in the delivery of the Services shall comply with the TfL Code of Conduct (Appendix Y – TfL Policies). The Service Provider shall ensure that their personnel execute work activities on Site with minimal levels of noise and appropriate conduct.
- 2.5.4 Whilst on duty, the Service Provider's Personnel shall wear an appropriate uniform and Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) for the tasks being performed, and for the location in which they are operating. This shall be agreed with the Authority prior to the Commencement Date and prior to any proposed change in design or style. All uniforms and PPE must be distinguishable from that of Authority branded clothing.
- 2.5.5 Uniforms and/or PPE shall be clean and free from marks and soiling and shall be in good repair at all times.

2.6 Building Records Management

- 2.6.1 The Service Provider shall be responsible for maintaining maintenance and service records, compliance certificates, inspection programmes, orders, log

books, system files, documents and the relevant Health and Safety file(s) (including a location specific risk register) relating to the delivery of the Services at the Sites. These shall be held at the Sites. The Service Provider shall ensure that they remain fully up-to-date at all times, are fully detailed, legible, dated and signed by the Service Provider and they shall remain the property of the Authority.

- 2.6.2 The Service Provider shall store, retain and dispose of all records in accordance with the Authority's policies and procedures. The Service Provider shall hold all records electronically unless otherwise agreed with the Authority.
- 2.6.3 In the absence of records including, but not limited to, those listed at paragraph 2.6.1 above, the Service Provider shall create, manage and maintain appropriate records.
- 2.6.4 The Service Provider shall keep up-to-date disposal records for all hazardous waste.
- 2.6.5 The Service Provider shall have the items referred to in paragraphs 2.6.1 to 2.6.4 above available for inspection by the Authority within 1 day of the issue of the request for inspection.
- 2.6.6 Data shall be transmitted electronically by the Service Provider to the Authority in a format as required by the Authority.

2.7 Materials and Equipment

- 2.7.1 The Service Provider shall be responsible for the supply, delivery, offloading, storage (where no storage can be provided by the Authority) and testing of all materials, consumables, tools and equipment including all safety equipment necessary to undertake the Services.
- 2.7.2 The Service Provider shall provide to the Authority, on request, any data/information on the safe use and storage of all Service Provider materials, consumables, tools and equipment used at the Authority's Sites. The Service Provider shall ensure the most sustainable and energy efficient replacement materials, consumables, tools and equipment are selected wherever possible. Only 'Energy A+++', 'A++', 'A+' or A rated appliances shall be provided as replacements for appliances.
- 2.7.3 The Service Provider shall ensure replacement materials, consumables, tools and equipment demonstrate optimal Whole Life Costs, quality and performance for the Authority wherever possible.
- 2.7.4 The Service Provider shall submit details of materials, consumables, tools and equipment to be used in the delivery of the Services to the Authority for approval.

- 2.7.5 Any materials, consumables, tools and equipment which are provided by the Authority for use by the Service Provider, are solely for use in the delivery of the Services.
- 2.7.7 The Service Provider shall ensure that all tools, equipment or spares supplied and used in the delivery of Services is in good working order and are suitably identified and shall carry the correct and valid certification/licence, and where applicable, shall be used by the relevant trained operative. The Service Provider shall ensure all Equipment is suitably identified and maintain adequate records to satisfy an audit trail.
- 2.7.8 The Service Provider shall ensure that inspection, testing and servicing of Service Provider equipment and systems is undertaken to ensure they remain safe and available for operational use at all times.
- 2.7.9 The Service Provider shall maintain a record of any items of Authority's work equipment issued to the Service Provider's Personnel. Work equipment shall be inspected and maintained to ensure it remains safe and available for operational use at all times in accordance with the Provision and Use of Work Equipment Regulations 1998 (PUWER).
- 2.7.10 Materials used shall as far as reasonably practicable pose no hazard to health and shall not contravene any relevant regulations or statutory requirements. The labelling and handling of materials that may pose a health hazard shall be to the latest revision of the COSHH Regulations.
- 2.7.11 The Service Provider shall manage the stock levels of spare parts to ensure availability to replenish on a reactive basis at all times.

2.8 On-Site Storage & Accommodation

- 2.8.1 No office accommodation or vehicle parking facilities are provided at the Sites for the Service Provider's use. The Service Provider shall make their own arrangements in this respect and shall pay all fees and charges in connection therewith.
- 2.8.2 The Authority will endeavour to provide suitable welfare and storage facilities at the Sites but these cannot be guaranteed. The provision of such facilities shall be subject to local agreement.
- 2.8.3 Where such facilities are unavailable, the Service Provider shall make his own arrangements in this respect and shall pay all fees and charges in connection therewith.

2.9 Temporary Hoardings

- 2.9.1 The Service Provider shall provide temporary hoardings should they be required to deliver the Services. The Service Provider shall construct temporary hoardings in accordance with the Authority standards, S1027, Site Hoarding, Fencing and Barriers.

2.9.2 The Service Provider shall protect existing structures from damage during the delivery of the Services by the use of any necessary props, screens, fans, waterproof sheets, dust sheets and the like, and any damage caused shall be made good by the Service Provider.

2.10 Utilities

The Authority will provide water, gas and electricity to the Service Provider. At some London Underground stations, this will include a single-phase 110 volt supply. The Service Provider shall provide all electrical leads from the local socket outlet to the place of work, including all necessary extension leads. All leads shall be appropriately tested and tagged in accordance with all current Engineering and British Standards. The Service Provider shall use battery operated tools and equipment where possible to prevent circuits being overloaded.

2.11 Removal and Management of Waste

2.11.1 The Service Provider shall remove their own waste from Site, as well as any redundant equipment and parts.

2.11.2 The Service Provider shall ensure proper controls are kept on the disposal of waste and ensure all bye laws, regulations; statutory and legal requirements in respect of the disposal of waste are followed and fully complied with.

2.11.3 The Service Provider shall report to the Authority at the end of each period of all waste arising in the delivery of the Services.

2.12 The Authority's Helpdesk and Local Reporting Systems

2.12.1 The Authority operates a number of helpdesks and/or local reporting systems for reporting and recording faults by Authority personnel. Faults reported to the Service Provider will be via the Authority's helpdesk facility. Full details including the reporting process will be provided to the Service Provider during the mobilisation period.

2.12.2 The Service Provider shall provide a 24/7 call centre facility to respond to all faults reported by the Authority. The Service Provider's call centre facility shall be the contact point for the Authority and must be operated at all times by suitably trained personnel. The call centre facility shall be contactable by telephone, facsimile and email at all times. The Service Provider's call centre facility shall receive data from the Authority and shall share data with the Authority as required.

2.13 Additional Works

2.13.1 The Authority may require the Service Provider to provide Additional Works, on a temporary and/or ad hoc basis.

2.12.2 The process for the provision of Additional Works is defined in Schedule 6 Part C.

2.14 Responsible Procurement

2.14.1 The Service Provider and the Authority acknowledge and agree that the Mayor, in accordance with Section 155 of the GLA Act, has directed the Authority and its subsidiaries to do all things reasonably necessary to comply with (inter alia) the Responsible Procurement Policy in its procurement activities.

2.14.2 The Service Provider shall procure that its Sub-Contractors shall comply with, and shall provide such co-operation and assistance as may be reasonably requested by the Authority to enable the Authority to comply with, the Responsible Procurement Policy.

2.14.3 The Service Provider acknowledges and agrees that the Authority is required to develop a policy relating to the promotion of the procurement of goods and services in an ethical manner (the "Ethical Sourcing Policy") which shall reflect and be consistent with the relevant principles of the Responsible Procurement Policy and the Service Provider shall, and shall procure that all of its Sub-Contractors shall, comply with such Ethical Sourcing Policy to the extent it does not conflict with the Responsible Procurement Policy.

2.14.4 The Service Provider acknowledges and agrees that it (and its Sub-Contractors) shall be required to comply with any changes to the Responsible Procurement Policy (and any adjustment or amendment to the Ethical Sourcing Policy as a result of such amendment or adjustment to the Responsible Procurement Policy).

2.14.5 The Service Provider shall not be entitled to any addition to the Target Cost, the Defined Cost or the Fee in the event of any change to the Responsible Procurement Policy (and any change to the Ethical Sourcing Policy as a result of such change to the Responsible Procurement Policy).

2.14.6 The Service Provider shall procure that any Sub-Contractor is required to comply with the provisions of this Section 2.14 and the provisions of this are included in any sub-contract (of any tier).

2.14.7 The Service Provider shall not, and shall procure that any Sub-Contractor shall not, without the prior written consent of the Authority, vary or purport to vary the provisions contained in any contract or sub-contract in accordance with the operation of this Section 2.14.

3 SKILLS AND QUALIFICATIONS

3.1 Skills and Qualifications of Service Provider Personnel

- 3.1.1 The Service Provider shall provide personnel suitably qualified and experienced to deliver the Services.
- 3.1.2 The Service Provider shall ensure that there is a sufficient level of trained and competent personnel to provide all the requirements of the Services, at all required times.
- 3.1.3 The Service Provider shall provide personnel qualified and competent in the discipline they are performing. The Service Provider shall employ competent personnel who will be responsible for planning, overseeing and signing off completed works / tasks.
- 3.1.4 The Service Provider shall provide details of the number and types of personnel to which training will be provided to meet the skills and qualification requirements detailed above. The Service Provider's proposals shall be subject to agreement and approval by the Authority.

3.2 Authority Mandatory Training of Service Provider Personnel

- 3.2.1 In addition to the skills and qualifications requirements, set out in paragraph 3.1.1 to 3.1.4 above, the Service Provider's personnel is required to undertake Authority mandatory training courses as appropriate. The specific courses including the workplace areas and the personnel types to which the training applies. Full details will be provided to the Service Provider during the mobilisation period.
- 3.2.2 .

3.3 Competency Management and Training Plan

- 3.3.1 The Service Provider shall prepare a contract specific training plan for each of its personnel who are engaged in the delivery of the Services. This shall include:
- a) the skills and qualifications requirements as detailed in paragraph 3.1 above.
 - b) the Authority mandatory training requirements as detailed in paragraph 3.2 above; and
 - c) any other vocational, statutory or compliance training deemed necessary by the Service Provider.
- 3.3.2 The Service Provider shall review and update the training plan bi-annually.
- 3.3.3 The Service Provider shall provide personnel engaged in delivery of the Services with adequate training on the following, including, but not limited to:
- a) the tasks they have to perform;
 - b) use of all necessary equipment required to deliver the Services; and

- c) all relevant legislation, British Standards and Authority rules, procedures, standards and codes of practice which relate to delivery of the Services;

4 CATERING EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE

4.1 Introduction

- 4.1.1 Facilities Operations is responsible within TfL for the provision of Facilities Management Services to a range of Head Office Buildings.
- 4.1.2 Facilities Operations also provides a range of non-property services pan TfL i.e. catering, mail, reprographics and the Facilities Service Centre (FSC).
- 4.1.3 The Catering Equipment Maintenance Services detailed in this specification shall be delivered pan TfL, in support of the catering services.

4.2 Locations & Hours of Work

4.2.1 Locations

- 4.2.1.1 A complete list of Sites subject to the scope of Section 4 of this specification is provided in Appendix A – Services Matrix and Site Information in Appendix D.
- 4.2.1.2 The Service Provider shall be aware that plans to add/remove Sites or changes in Site populations within the estate may impact on the Catering Equipment Maintenance requirement. The Service Provider shall therefore be required to adopt a flexible approach to change the focus of the Service, as circumstances dictate.

4.2.2 Hours of Work

- 4.2.2.1 The Service Provider shall deliver the Services set out in section 4 of this specification both inside and outside of Core Hours. Core Hours are defined as 08:00 to 18:00 Monday to Friday. All other times including public/bank holidays and Christmas Day are regarded as outside Core Hours.
- 4.2.2.2 The Service Provider shall deliver the Services outside of the Core Hours where working within the Core Hours would adversely impact the Site catering operation or its occupant's activities. The Service Provider shall accommodate requests to change the scheduling of particular aspects of the Services to accommodate the Authority's specific operational requirements, at no additional cost to the Authority.

4.3 Scope of Services

4.3.1 Scope

- 4.3.1.1 The Service Provider shall provide a Fully Comprehensive fit for purpose maintenance service, inclusive of all labour and standard parts (including water softeners) that brings knowledge, experience and skills to the delivery of

the Services and ensures the effective operation of all items of catering equipment as detailed within the Authority's asset register and any subsequent updates.

4.3.1.2 The Services include but are not limited to, the management, maintenance and inspection of:

- Catering Equipment
- Microwave emission testing
- Portable appliances inspection and testing services (PAT)
- Fabrication
 - Sinks
 - Workbenches
 - Counters
- Earth Bonding
- Asset condition surveys
- Procurement of Catering Equipment
- Off-site storage of Catering Equipment
- Safe disposal of surplus or redundant Catering Equipment

4.4 Standards

4.4.1 General

4.4.1.1 The Services shall be provided at all times in accordance with a regime that complies with all statutory requirements, legislation, regulations and the standards set out in this specification .

4.4.2 TfL Standards

4.4.2.1 The Service Provider shall comply with all applicable TfL Standards as they relate to the delivery of the Services.

4.4.2.2 The Service Provider shall perform the Services to the required standards as set out within this specification and shall be adjudged by the targets and results of the Authority's Performance Measurement System (PMS) and other associated performance measures relating to fault clearance, resource provision and completion of periodic catering equipment maintenance tasks defined in Schedule 11 Performance Measurement.

4.4.3 British Standards, Regulations & Approved Codes of Practice

4.4.3.1 The Service Provider shall provide the Services in accordance with a regime that complies with all relevant British Standards.

4.5 Services Specification

4.5.1 Scope of Maintenance

- 4.5.1.1 All catering equipment assets within the designated catering facilities including kitchens; store rooms and serving areas, are owned by the Authority and are provided for the catering Service Provider's sole use in the provision of the catering services. Asset Registers by Site are included in Appendix E.
- 4.5.1.2 The Service Provider shall provide a professionally managed, Fully Comprehensive planned and reactive catering and associated equipment service in accordance with the specified Standards and Asset Register (including subsequent updates) to ensure the effective operation and functionality of all items of catering equipment, including on-floor hub/mess area equipment where indicated, with the exception of hot/cold water dispensers, across all sites.
- 4.5.1.3 The Service Provider shall deliver a planned and reactive catering equipment maintenance service, which seeks to actively reduce the risk of reactive repairs and maintenance and enhances asset life cycle.
- 4.5.1.4 The Service Provider's planned and reactive services shall include, but not be limited to:
- a) Ensuring catering equipment is properly and safely maintained and remains functional, safe and operationally sound
 - b) Inspection and repair of all stainless steel tables and food preparation surfaces. Repairs to draws and wheels including trolleys are required
 - c) Inspection and repair of sink and wash hand basins, including taps and spray rinse attachments.
 - d) Descaling all dishwashers; plumbed water boilers, tap and spray rinse attachments; and counter top beverage machines
 - e) Replacing water filtration or softener cartridges filters fitted to catering equipment assets as required.
 - f) Emission testing of microwaves
 - g) PAT testing of electrical catering equipment including electrical appliances sited within catering offices and associated areas.
 - h) Inspection and maintenance of all earth bonding as required within the catering facility
 - i) General support to the delivery of the Authority's catering service as required
- 4.5.1.5 The Service Provider shall be responsible for any services up to the point where the appliance is isolated from the supply and to where any waste trap from the appliance connects with the local waste pipes.
- 4.5.1.6 The Service Provider shall maintain Site log books. Each Site log book shall contain but not limited to, copies of the PPM schedule; technicians site attendance reports; PAT and microwave emissions testing sheets; Risk and Method Statements (RAMS) for each task that relates to the service provision.

4.5.2 Contract Asset Register

- 4.5.2.1 The Authority operates an Asset Management system, which holds the Authority's Asset Register. The Authority shall control and manage the Asset Register.
- 4.5.2.2 The Service Provider shall review and verify the Authority's assets during the first 12 months following the Contract Commencement Date, validating current assets and highlighting any assets found and not included within the Asset Register. The Service Provider shall survey all the Authority's assets to assess their current condition and to consider the likelihood of equipment failure and advice on a capital replacement programme for the duration of the contract period.
- 4.5.2.3 The Service Provider shall ensure that all records of testing of Assets required by this Specification are accessible by the Authority at all times.
- 4.5.2.4 The Service Provider shall propose any relevant changes and updates to the Authority ensuring the Asset register is maintained and up to date at all times. The Service Provider shall ensure that data held in the Asset Register shall be in the format and hierarchy prescribed by the Authority.
- 4.5.2.5 Working in liaison with the Authority, the Service Provider shall identify those Assets/Sites, which are business critical and those which are not business critical
- 4.5.2.6 The Service Provider shall maintain any additional assets added to the Sites subject to the agreement of a Variation Order submitted to the Authority by the Service Provider.

4.5.3 Planned Preventative Maintenance (PPM) Service Delivery

- 4.5.3.1 The Service Provider shall create, update and issue for the Authority's approval the Annual PPM Schedule for all Sites.
- 4.5.3.2 The Authority shall provide any comments or feedback on the Annual PPM Schedule to the Service Provider within 30 days of the commencement of the Contract.
- 4.5.3.3 The Service Provider shall make the Annual PPM Schedule available in a format to be agreed between the Parties, to the Authority for inspection by it or a third party appointed by the Authority at any time.
- 4.5.3.4 The Service Provider shall deliver planned maintenance in accordance with the Annual PPM Schedule.
- 4.5.3.5 The Service Provider shall notify the Authority no less than seven (7) days in advance of any proposed changes to the dates or locations of the PPM Schedule and shall undertake the planned maintenance on the proposed changed date only if approved in advance by the Authority.

- 4.5.3.6 If during the planned maintenance, the Service Provider identifies faults where there is a risk of danger to persons and/or property, the Service Provider shall make sure such faults are safe immediately and shall report the hazard to the Authority as soon as practicable but in any case within two (2) hours of making the faults safe.
- 4.5.3.7 If during the planned maintenance, the Service Provider identifies faults that require rectifying by other Service Providers, which are impacting on the safe and reliable operation of the catering equipment assets, for example power sockets; gas supplies; pest control and so on, the Service Provider shall notify the Authority as soon as practicable.

4.5.4 Reactive Maintenance Service Delivery

- 4.5.4.1 The Service Provider shall deliver a Reactive Maintenance service in accordance with the Service Response Times as defined in the Performance Measurement table of Schedule 9 to meet the Standards of this specification.
- 4.5.4.2 The Service Provider shall receive instructions to carry out Reactive Maintenance from the Authority's FSC (helpdesk).
- 4.5.2.3 The Service Provider shall attend the Sites and permanently rectify faults. The Service Provider shall endeavour to permanently rectify each fault during a single attendance visit but if necessary the Service Provider shall make more than one attendance visit to make safe or permanently rectify the fault.
- 4.5.2.4 At the end of each attendance visit the fault shall be left in a safe condition if it cannot be permanently rectified.
- 4.5.2.5 The Service Provider shall notify the Authority's FSC when faults have been permanently rectified or made safe.
- 4.5.2.6 If, when undertaking reactive maintenance, the Service Provider discovers the need to undertake additional remedial works, this shall be treated as a fault. The Service Provider shall report the fault to the Authority's FSC and shall attend and permanently rectify the fault.

4.6 Additional Works Requirements

- 4.6.1 The Service Provider shall undertake any fabrication works as required to stainless steel work surfaces; supporting structures; sink units or counters on acceptance by the Authority of an Additional Works quotation provided by the Service Provider.
- 4.6.2 The Service Provider shall replace any glass fittings such as sneeze screens; racking or shelving units and counter display units, which are damaged and present a health and safety hazard on acceptance by the Authority of an Additional Works quotation provided by the Service Provider.

- 4.6.3 The Authority may request a quotation from the Service Provider to supply new or replacement catering and associated equipment, although there is no guarantee that the quote will be accepted.
- 4.6.4 The Service Provider shall receive and temporary warehouse any new, replacement or surplus equipment including any equipment purchased directly by the Authority or the Catering Service Provider. The Service Provider shall ensure that any such items are kept secure and are fully insured to cover any loss or damage, whilst in the Service Providers possession and/or in transit.
- 4.6.5 The Service Provider shall deliver to Site any new, replacement or surplus equipment from the temporary warehouse or directly from Site to Site.
- 4.6.6 The Service Provider shall be responsible for installing and commissioning new, replacement, or surplus equipment into Sites. The Service Provider shall undertake any minor modifications that may be required to install or relocate equipment.
- 4.6.7 The Service Provider shall provide general labour to move equipment; either within a catering facility or from Site to Site.
- 4.6.8 The Service Provider may be requested to maintain catering equipment in other TfL locations, where there is not a catering service provided. Equipment may include but not limited to refrigeration units, dishwashers; oven ranges and microwaves.
- 4.6.9 The Service Provider shall ensure the safe removal and lawful disposal of unwanted equipment in accordance with the current legislation.
