Between: The Department for Transport (The Customer) and NCC Group Security Services Limited (The Supplier)

1. The Contract is varied as follows:

- 1.1 The customer requires the contract with NCC Group Security Services Limited for The supply of Cyber Security Services / Consultancy for the Department for Transport to be extended by six (6) months due to delays in work caused by the Covid-19 pandemic. The current Pandemic has caused issues with availability of staff and access to the necessary resources to complete the work
- 1.2 The original contract had an extension provision included which was implemented and took the contract end date to 15th August 2020. The Customer and Supplier have requested to extend the contract on a time-only basis to allow sufficient time for them to complete the work.
- 1.3 The original Contract length including the extension was twelve (12) months and due to expire on the 15th August 2020. The Contract is being extended by a further six months expiring on 15th February 2021 This is due to the delays on the works being undertaken for the Contract which have been caused by the Covid-19 pandemic.
- 1.4 This extension does not change the original Contract value of £100,000.00 (Excluding VAT).
- 1.5 This Contract Variation is permitted under Regulation 72 (1)(c) which is written as follows:
 - 1.5.1 Where all of the following conditions are fulfilled:—
 - Part (i) of Regulation 72 (1) (c) is met as the need for modification has been brought about by circumstances which a diligent contracting authority could not have foreseen (Covid-19);
 - Part (ii) of Regulation 72 (1) (c) is met as the modification does not alter the overall nature of the contract;
 - Part (iii) of Regulation 72 (1) (c) is met as there is no increase in price of the original contract or framework agreement.

2. Words and expressions in this Change Control Notice shall have the meanings given to them in the Contract.

3. The Contract, including any previous Contract changes, authorised in writing by both Parties, shall remain effective and unaltered except as amended by this Change Control Notice.
