Highways England has a requirement to deliver construction works to maintain, repair and renew the Strategic Road Network (SRN) within Highways England Areas 13 and 14. Construction Works Framework (CWF) will be made up of a number of different contractors from different specialist areas who will work together to deliver network improvements and maintenance schemes within Area 13 and 14.
