
Chippenham Fen National Nature Reserve How to find us.





- Sat nav use CB7 5QB (approximate and will not get you to the NE office).
- What 3 Words: Rumble.Rave.Landlady
- Grid ref: TL 651691

Chippenham Fen NNR is located close to the village of Chippenham in Cambridgeshire. Around 5 miles north of Newmarket.

The reserve is accessed via a gated track off the Chippenham to Snailwell road. Entrance is adjacent to Park Farm.

The entrance is on a dangerous blind corner when approaching from Chippenham.

We recommend you drive past Park Farm, toward Snailwell, then turn around in the layby on High Park Corner and approach from this direction. This is a much safer approach as you are not cutting across into oncoming traffic, on a blind bend.

A metal gate controls access to the track to the NNR. Between 0730-1300hrs it should open automatically, when you drive slowly towards it. Please contact the NNR office for 'Out of hours' code.

Proceed through the farmyard and past Phantom cottages. **Be Alert to Farm Traffic**.

Please drive <u>Dead Slow past our neighbours in Phantom Cottages to reduce noise, dust & mudissues.</u>

Parking is outside the NNR base.
