


Padel court Hyde Park / Regents Park November 2016:





Strip foundation for the installation of 1 Paddle Court



Recommended cross-section for floor construction



As an alternative you can use a simple reinforced concrete slab with a slope on the short side (10m) of 0.7% -1%

IMPORTANT:

Strip foundations and reinforced concrete slabs must be protected from frozen underground water.

10,70 m EXPLANATION: At a depth of around 80 cm, the soil temperature drops, even at icy Winters, never below 0°C, therefore the strip foundation needs to be frost-prooved at min. 80 cm, or with 100 cm it's even better. If water and ice will be collected under the foundation, it can push the foundation strips with tremendous upward force and would inevitably cracks and may lead to glass breakage.


Width strip foundation:
