The Integrated Operating Concept 2025 sets out the case for adaptation in Defence, articulating the changes to the threats and the challenges faced by the UK. Multi-Domain Integration (MDI) is the posturing of military capabilities in concert with other instruments of national power, including those of allies and partners. Multi-Domain Integration will be achieved through the fusion of capabilities and activity across all domains at a tempo which outstrips our adversaries.

Multi-Domain Integration is not an equipment programme, but is dependent on change, some of which is equipment centric to deliver an enhancement. Multi-Domain Integration has five key elements:

- Increasing (or enhancing) capabilities
- Orchestrating activity and effects
- Improving understanding
- Creating agility at all levels
- Enhancing global reach

Multi-Domain Integration is being realised through a defence change programme led by Strategic Command, working in collaboration with Head Office and the Front-Line Commands.

The Multi-Domain Integration industry day will provide industry and academia with the aims of Multi-Domain Integration , the drivers for change, its concept and how the ambitions will be delivered. The day includes workshops between the MOD, industry and academia.
