## Following survey of owned trees to carry out on behalf of Church Crookham Parish Council:

- 1) Moderate priority tree works at all locations as per 2022 survey requirements seeking relevant permissions from the local authority Hart District Council
- 2) Low priority tree works at all locations as per 2022 survey requirements seeking relevant permissions from the local authority Hart District Council
- 3) Young tree management at all locations to potentially including aftercare eg. Mulching and watering during long dry spells to improve viability
- 4) Woodland management at all relevant locations as per 2022 survey requirements seeking relevant permissions from the local authority Hart District Council
- 5) To carry out ad-hoc emergency work or work required due to mid-survey cycle tree decline related work
- 6) To plant trees/ hedges in replacement of removed tree/ hedges and to enhance the tree/hedge population of Church Crookham ensuring each tree/hedge is planted to ensure its best possible viability
- 7) To work within the parish council annual budget and future proposed budget for a minimum term of 2 survey cycles i.e. 6 years with an option to extend for a 3rd survey cycle.

- b) Use of fully trained staff members to include evidence of chain saw certification
- c) Comprehensive insurance to cover all arboricultural activities to be evidenced
- d) All works to be carried out to BS3998: 2010 or equivalent recommendations for tree works
- e) To include removal of arisings from site whilst seeking to recycle / reuse where possible e.g. chippings to mulch newly planted trees and hedges
- f) To be able to respond to emergencies in a rapid fashion in the locality of Church Crookham, North East Hampshire
