

Outputs:

- Landscape review of current WVCM guidance
- Series of stakeholder consultations
- Final output document to include:
- o An initial set of approaches/principles to shape "high integrity" WVCM.
- o Accompanying set of visual tools and resources, drawn from the landscape review, which illustrate a business journey through implementation of WVCM activities, considering varying contexts and perspectives and how these align with existing frameworks.
- o Two illustrative semi-theoretical scenarios for a UK supply chain and global supply chain (global scenario must be a priority forest-risk commodity such as cattle, soy, palm oil, coffee, or cocoa) showing the principles/approaches applied to the chosen commodity and context. The scenarios will demonstrate activities which address context specific variables, perspectives, and considerations.
- o Identify recommendations for suitable commodities and regions to deep dive into as potential next phase of work to further demonstrate approaches/principles in practice on the ground in these contexts.
- Recommendations for government and wider stakeholder action to unblock barriers.
- o Final report/outputs must be an accessible entry point into the landscape of WVCM for Chief Sustainability Officers and corporate decision makers, which illustrates the journey/process to develop & implement WVCM strategies, and signposts relevant standards, guidance, and tools.
