### 1. Introduction / Executive Summary

- 1.1 This paper seeks approval to proceed with the award of the provision of Speed Awareness Training, for people who were caught speeding and for drivers who have driven through red lights in London, and decide to opt for the course rather than accept penalty points, to AA DriveTech Limited.
- 1.2 AA DriveTech Ltd provided an excellent, compliant bid and the Most Economically Advantageous Tender submission. It is therefore recommended that the Contract to manage the Speed Awareness Training programme be awarded to AA DriveTech Ltd. The duration would be for an initial period of three years the option to extend for a further two years.
