### 2.1 Services required:

(Call Off Schedule 2 (Services))

#### **Background**

The country is in the midst of a coronavirus pandemic. Working with national partners, the Department has established a national programme aimed at coordinating coronavirus testing in order to: save lives, accurately diagnose acutely unwell patients, identify key workers in isolation who can continue to work and provide the general public with a test to identify immunity.

#### **Background to the Requirement**

Previous work had delivered phase 1 of a two part service; the first part being the establishment of an analytics workstream and the second to provide a flexible “trouble shooting team” to help address key issues when they arise. It is in respect of the second part this requirement refers.

The objective is to help answer the following two questions:

How much daily testing capacity is there through May within National Health Service (NHS) laboratories given current supplies?

How can we get sufficient data to have a view on how to allocate supplies to meet demand (now and in the future)?

#### **Scope**

##### Workstream 1: Mapping supplier data to network / platform capacity

- A. Updating the assessment of the maximum possible capacity (i.e., supply unconstrained) at NHS labs
- B. Obtaining data to provide a perspective of how supply could be allocated using the Testing programme’s optimisation model
- C. Developing a refined view on the resultant number of tests that can be done given expected supplies through May

##### Workstream 2: Routes to improving supplier delivery data

- D. Developing a perspective on possible routes to improving supplier delivery data?

#### **Deliverables:**

Document summarising:

- (a) Refined view of current (unconstrained) capacity
- (b) View of current supply for select suppliers (to be agreed with the head of the Supply Team) and how these could be allocated
- (c) Perspective on number of tests which could be completed per day based on current pipeline of supplies
- (d) Options for how to improve supply data quality going forward
