

1. Description of the work:

Objective

The objective of this contract is to appoint a Contractor to provide Early Supplier Engagement Services (ESE) to various projects and studies across the Warwickshire & Avon Catchment Based Group. The role of the ESE Contractor is to provide advice relating to construction costing and option buildability.

This Catchment Based Group's aim is to enable initial investigatory works to be undertaken in development of the pipeline programme (pre SOC approval work).

Specification

In managing the services the Consultant shall:

- a) To work in collaboration with the *Client* and wider project team to assist in developing the best value design solutions;
- b) The Consultant will identify Health & Safety issues, potential value engineering opportunities, carbon reduction opportunities, sustainability opportunities and efficiencies in delivery;
- c) The Consultant will assist the design Consultant in the identification of project risks and opportunities and the development of the project risk log; including estimating the cost of risks realisation and mitigation measures. The Consultant will attend and contribute to risk workshops.
- d) The *Consultant* will assist the design Consultant in identifying potential opportunities to create enhancements and improve the local environment/amenity value and contribute to urban regeneration;
- e) The Consultant will participate in optioneering workshops and assist in the process of short listing options as well as providing option costs for project team review and assessment;
- f) The Consultant will assist in determining suitable locations for site compound(s). Consider issues of; area required, including for storage, safe and environmentally acceptable access and egress between the compound and working areas (taking account of the size and nature of plant required
- g) The *Consultant* will assist in determining suitable access routes, considering issues of working in conservation areas and working in public open spaces.
- h) The *Consultant* will take the lead on determining suitable solutions for items where the contractor is likely to be responsible for design liability.
- i) The *Consultant* will assist the design consultant with development of a construction programme (end to end programme).
- j) Contribute to the project efficiency register.
- k) Attend project meetings the *Client* invites the *Consultant* to attend.
- I) Produce monthly financial updates and forecasts meeting the *Client's* project reporting timetable together with progress reports.
- m) Deliver a monthly progress report in the *Client's* standard template giving progress against programme, deliverables received and expected and financial summary against programme.
- n) Co-operate with the *Client* in the role of the BIM Information Manager
- o) Challenge and review stakeholder Engagement and Quality.
