No vehicles are permitted to park on the grass verges. No vehicles are permitted to travel over grass verges to pass one another. The contractor shall be required to instruct all delivery drivers and subcontractors to comply. Photos shall be taken by the contractor prior to commencement as a record of the state of drive and verges. The contractor shall be respectful of the public who are using the site and manage construction traffic sensitively.

- Vehicle turning permitted at traffic island ahead except when in use by the anglican chapel.
  - Suggested location of welfare cabin
  - Red line denotes contractors secure compound area to be fenced off and securely locked out of hours.
  - Indicative 6 wheeler 15 tonne delivery lorry
  - Turning area (when anglican chapel is in use or access to turning circle beyond is otherwise prevented)
  - Where proposed temporary water supply is routed across access road, suitable protection to be put in place
  - Approximate location of water supply standpipe. Proposed route of temporary hose to supply construction site and welfare facilities shown in dotted blue line
  - Green area denotes the road access which must be kept clear from parked vehicles.
  - Temporary contractor vehicle parking permitted here
  - Access to site via private drive accessed off main road. Traffic is fast moving, suitable signage should be in place to signal to delivery drivers that they are approaching the site.
