#### Task Title:

Provision of Support for Hawk Type Airworthiness Authority (TAA) to support Hawk Project India Military Registered Civil Operated Aircraft (MRCOA)

#### Brief Description of Task:

Provision of technical specialist support to enable the Hawk TAA to deliver Hawk Project India MRCOA clearance process. This shall include facilitation of compliance with MAA RAs 1121 &1123 for the UK Hawk TAA.

#### Background/Justification:

UK TAAs have recently supported BAE with MRCOA arrangements for Hawk T-165, Typhoon and Tornado aircraft. There are considerable differences between the Hawk TMk2 and the Project India aircraft so the Hawk TAA must assure the MRCOA clearance. The SOR at Annex A identifies the resources required to ensure that the Hawk TAA receives sufficient support to conduct MRCOA clearance activities.

The BAES Project India drives the timing requirement of Military Registration of aircraft and the preceding assurance activity that culminates in issue by the Sponsor of CoU. First flight is expected in June 2017. Post first flight it is expected the configuration of the aircraft will continue to evolve. These changes will need to be assessed to provide design and configuration assurance.

Given the lead time to complete the MRCOA registration in time for the first flight (June 2017) the Hawk MRCOA Assurance Project shall start immediately (25 April 2017), in order to support Sponsor and TAA in their assurance work.

Post first flight it is expected the configuration of the aircraft will continue to evolve. These changes will need to be assessed to provide design and configuration assurance.

#### Activities to be Undertaken:

- 1. Provision of dedicated Technical support resource to provide ac design certification SME knowledge to enable the assurance of airworthiness of the aircraft for Project India by providing assurance evidence in accordance with RA 1121. The task will include providing an audit plan to enable assurance activity to be targeted at risk to life risks, ensuring appropriate safety, airworthiness and design standards have been raised by BAE Systems, and the analysis of those areas that fall short of the standards expected. There needs to be intelligent interpretation of what RA1121 contains for each stage and the requirements of MRCOA assurance presented in a clear and concise matter to the Authority and Sponsor of the project. The bulk of this work is required between 25 April 2017 to 30 June 2017 with review activity undertaken until 12 November 2017.
- 2. RA1121 requires the Authority to assure itself of the design. Once the assurance activity is identified by the certification SME, technical support resource will be needed to provide individual disciplines (ie flight science, test flt operations, system safety) to assure compliance with the standards set, using the artefacts produced by the Applicant (BAE Systems). The request for this tasking will be short notice following the production of the audit plan and will be conducted between 25 April 2017 and 31 August 2017. The depth of assurance activity will be dependant on the audit requirements and any non-compliance to standards found.
- 3. The 'Certificate of Use' must remain valid and remain valid for the duration of the project. One aspect of this Certificate is the establishment of the 'as-built' configuration and this configuration conforms to the 'as-design' configuration. Given the fast flowing nature of this programme there is a high probability that these configurations may diverge. On Site audit activity at BAES Warton to conduct independent review of Quality Management process will be necessary assurance of the aircraft build configuration and any changes made during the project. The majority of this work will take place prior to certificate provision on 30 June 2017 with a small review activity post that activity to assure any modification activity.
  - 4. Attend and support the following meetings:
    - a. Monthly Progress Meetings (Building 1300, Bristol).
    - b. Weekly Project Review Meetings (either BAES, Warton or Building 1300, Bristol)
