#### 5 Evaluation Criteria

#### 5.1 Weighting

The Most Economically Advantageous Tender is one that has the lowest evaluated cost and not necessarily the lowest submitted cost. The criteria which the Authority(s) will use to determine that an offer is the most economically advantageous are included in the quality questions and specification.

Criteria	Weighting (%)
Price	40%
Quality Questions	60%

The evaluation will be carried out by a panel, made up of a number of Authority(s) staff that will conclude a panel consensus score for each bidder. Scores will be entered into a spreadsheet that, when taking into account the weightings for each section, will calculate the score applied.

#### 6 Evaluation Process

Evaluations will be carried out in the following stages:

- Submission of all required documents by bidders (please see section 1.2 of '1. ITT ITT General Information & Instructions to Bidders')
- Check to see whether Form of Offer has been completed. If it has not been completed, then the bid cannot be considered further and may be rejected.
- Individual evaluation of quality questions by evaluators
- Moderation session to agree consensus scores for the quality questions, if any question
  is given a score of 0 then the bidder will be excluded from the competition. This will be
  done before pricing is evaluated.
- Pricing will be evaluated and scored.
- Combining of scores for pricing and quality questions to determine the highest scoring
- Award notification to successful and unsuccessful bidders.

### 6.1 Pricing

Pricing will be evaluated using the Commercials spreadsheet. Pricing is evaluated against the projected cost of the service based on the rates entered into the pricing schedule. The method outlined in 3.1 of the '1. ITT General Information & Instructions to Bidders' will then be applied to determine the score.

#### 6.2 Evaluation Criteria

Quality questions will be evaluated using the following criteria:

Score	Quality of the Response
5	Meets all requirements and offers some added value
4	Meets all requirements
3	Generally meets all requirements with minor issues
2	Meets some requirements but with a few major gaps/issues
1	Meets few requirements; serious concerns
0	Does not meet any requirements or fails to answer

#### 6.3 Contract Award

The contract will be awarded to the bidder with highest combined score for pricing and quality. If final scores have two or more bidders within a half a percent (0.5%) of each other, then Authority(s) reserves the right to request a final and best pricing offer(s) from these bidders. The bidder with the highest score following this will be awarded the contract. This is intended to ensure there is a one clear winning bidder.
