Many thanks to you and your team for the excellent efforts that you have put into responding to the crucial Ventilator Challenge. Whilst this device does not meet the published specification, the ventilation challenge team have agreed to look at it as is fulfils a complimentary clinical purpose. We would therefore like to give you and your supply chain confidence to continue. Specifically:

- We commit to purchasing a proof of principle early manufacturing run of up to 100 devices, subject to MHRA approval, dependant on how many devices you want to test in UCL hospitals.
- We would like to support you as you activate your supply chain and we urge your manufacturers to prioritise components that can be used to produce ventilators. A letter has been prepared as such which we will share with you
- We would like to help you get any support you need to work with MHRA safety issues would need to be resolved before the devices could be put into clinical practice. MHRA approval will be needed.
- We would require a written report on safety before we agree to further manufacture.
- This is subject to proposed prices as discussed and agreed with the NHS we expect
 the pricing for the units to be in line with current prices paid by the NHS for these
 units.
