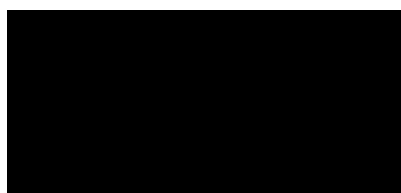
Feedback on your technical response also accompanies this letter. If you would like further feedback on your tender, please submit a query via the Jaggaer portal under the ITT for this procurement.

Two contracts will be awarded following this tendering process. Your contract reference will be **TRCF3078B**. The other successful supplier is **CBRE**, with a total score of **95**. The two contracts together will have an initial term of 3 years, with the option to extend for a further year. Together, these contracts will have maximum value of £1.5m per year, allocated evenly between the two suppliers.

A standstill period will now occur before the contract can be formally awarded to allow any appeals against the proposed award decision to be lodged. The standstill period will commence on **16/10/2023** and finish on **30/10/2023**. The Department will therefore not enter into a contract before **30/10/2023**.
