Two contracts will be awarded following this tendering process. Your contract reference will be **TRCF3078B.** The other successful supplier is **CBRE**, with a total score of **95**. The two contracts together will have an initial term of 3 years, with the option to extend for a further year. Together, these contracts will have maximum value of £1.5m per year, allocated evenly between the two suppliers.

A standstill period will now occur before the contract can be formally awarded to allow any appeals against the proposed award decision to be lodged. The standstill period will commence on 16/10/2023 and finish on 30/10/2023. The Department will therefore not enter into a contract before 30/10/2023.
