



Call off Schedule 20 – Specification

Analytical resource is required to support critical work required by the end of June 2024 in order to establish an older products dataset. This will involve finding and mapping reference prices for all older products, Quality Assurance of matching work ahead of implementation of the 2024 voluntary scheme, and consideration of the outcomes of this work with respect to operational models and monitoring of the scheme.

The resource in question has been committed to this project since May 2023 and therefore has (1) strong understanding of the different rules bases of the scheme and the intent behind them, (2) already demonstrated strong skills in developing dataset matching techniques required, and (3) has experience of working in this extremely complex area, and the data sources, which will be used to carry out the data matching.
