

GREEN LANE COMMUNITY PATH HADDENHAM

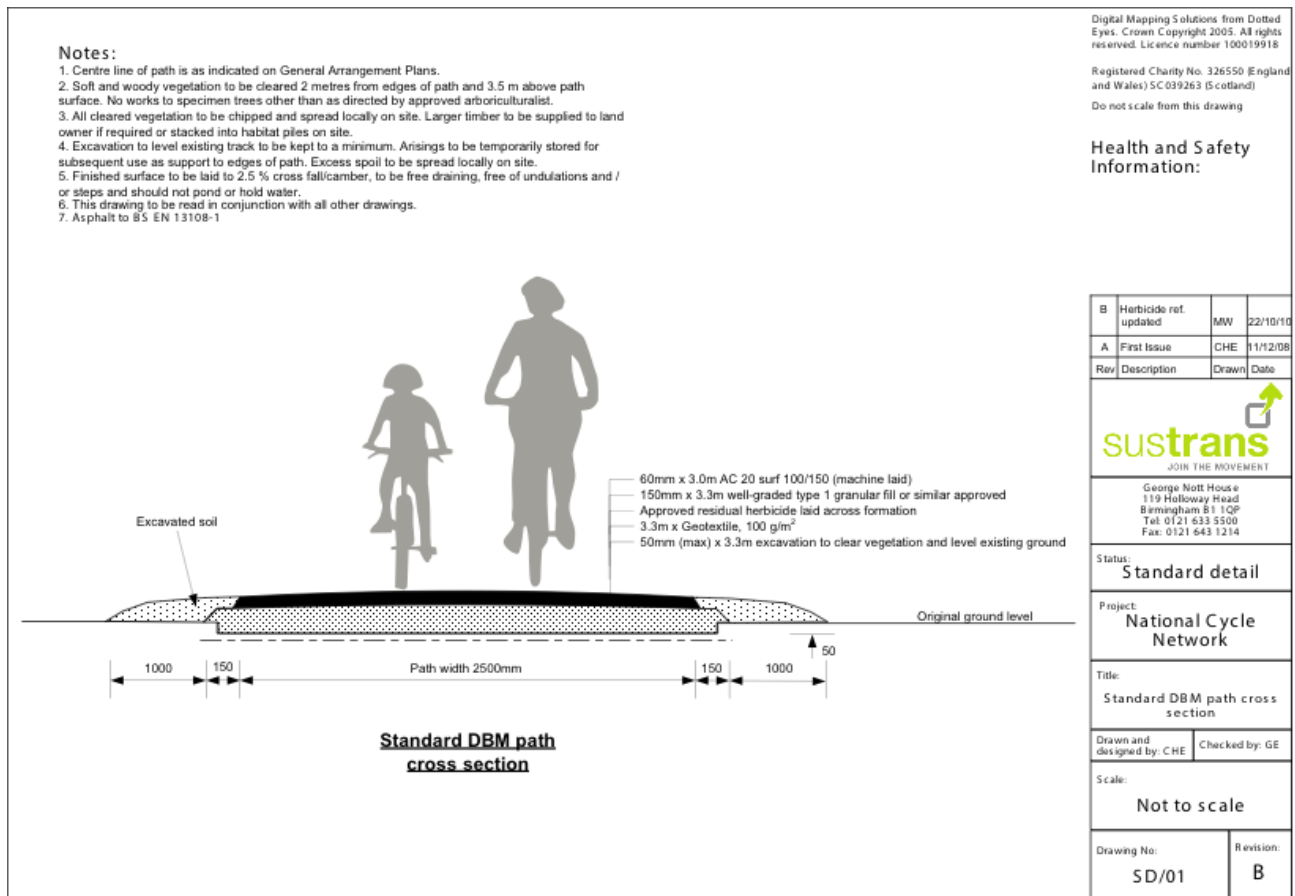


The existing bridleway runs from opposite Haddenham Post Office, towards Dinton and then turns left over a ditch to travel up to the A418 just W of the old bus garage.

Specification

- The new path will start from this gateway, marked **A** on the map, where the current 6m wide hardcore surface ends. Access for construction vehicles is possible from the Haddenham Post Office End and from the A418.
- 1) Clear all trees and undergrowth to a width of 5 metres, for approximately 1000 metres in length. All material to be burnt on site.
 - 2) Excavate trench and lay 6 metre ribbed pipe to form culvert where stream passes across path. Backfill over pipe with compacted MOT and construct head walls to each end using sandbags filled with concrete.

3) Excavate 1000 linear metres of track. Lay 1000g membrane, 150mm of compacted type 1 or similar approved and top off with 60mm of 20mm binder course tarmac as per Sustrans Specification:



Regrade soil to edges of tarmac on completion using material saved when track excavated.

4) Footpath up to A418 from B to C. This will consist of exactly the same construction as in no 3 but without the layer of tarmac. The width will be 3 metres.

5) Provide and erect 4 wooden barriers as requested, 2 at each end of the path with one each side of the path to prevent use of the path by vehicles but allow wheelchairs and horses admittance.

Timescales

1. Quotations must be in by 30th August 2017.
2. Site visits can be arranged 15th - 18th August 2017.
3. The work should start as soon as possible and construction complete by 30th April 2018 at the latest.
