The Tender is for the delivery of a suite of works, covering the supply and delivery of materials as well as installation and application, as summarised below:

- Appropriate storage of Materials, as necessary.
- Installation of Stone Dams, Peat Dams, and Heather Bales into gullies
- Installation of Peat Bunding
- · Re-profiling of hags and gully sides
- Spreading of Heather Brash on bare peat
- Spreading of Lime, Seed, and Fertiliser
- Cutting of heather
- Planting of Sphagnum Plug plants
- Planting of Sedge and Dwarf Shrub Plug plants
- Creation of fire breaks using bunds, cutting and sphagnum planting
- Removal of Waste Materials from Site.
