8. Refurbishment Specification prior to entering service.
9. Route Risk Assessment - The Corporation acknowledges receipt of the Route Risk Assessment pertaining to route 186.
10. Contract Price Adjustment – applied from Tranche 730 onwards:

Paragraph 9.2.2 is deleted and replaced by the following:

The percentage price adjustment (R) is a 12-month rolling average given by: -
