- 1.3.2 The unit price of the products listed in **Table 1a** above is agreed to be used at the time of purchas The Supplier shall apply the Price in the table above for POs raised from Contract Commencement Date
- 1.4. Contract Price payment profile
- 1.4.1 Payment terms are net 30 days from receipt of a valid invoice.
- 1.4.2 In accordance with clause 2.6.1 of this Contract the Authority will send one or more unique purchase orders ("**PO**") for either the Premises and Locations for their total requirements.
- 1.4.3 Any purchase order issued by the Authority in respect of this Contract does not form part of this Contract.
- 1.4.5 All invoices must be sent to quoting a valid PO number.
- 1.4.6 To avoid delay in payment it is important that the Supplier provides a compliant invoice that ncludes, as a minimum, a valid PO number, PO line-item number (if applicable), PO line description, and the details (name and telephone number) of the Authority's authorised representative. Non compliant invoices will be sent back to the Supplier, which may lead to a delay in a payment.
