Contract Variation no.2: Rail Tracker Survey


1. On behalf of the Secretary of State for Transport, this letter confirms a variation to the time and value of the contract detailed in the award letter dated 21st January 2020.
2. Following a number of delays due to Covid, the contract variation is required to continue gathering evidence from rail users and non-users to understand whether the William-Shapps Review is achieving against its stated objectives.
3. As a result, it is necessary to amend the contract value. The contract value has been extended by an additional £35,000. The approved increase brings the maximum cost of the contract to **£308,750** excluding VAT. This amount includes the original award value of £270,000 and the first value extension of £3,750.
4. The contract length has also been increased for five months and will expire on **31st May 2022**.
5. The terms and conditions on the contract are unchanged.
