

WWF-UK SOURCING PROCESS TERMS & CONDITIONS

IN PARTICIPATING IN THIS SOURCING PROCESS WITH WWF-UK (WHETHER RFI, RFQ OR RFP), YOU ARE DEEMED TO ACCEPT AND ACKNOWLEDGE THE FOLLOWING:

This Sourcing Process and any other supplementary information provided to you contains WWF-UK confidential information and shall remain at all times the property of WWF-UK.

1. This Sourcing Process will involve the disclosure to you of WWF-UK confidential information. No part of the Sourcing Process may be reproduced, in whole or in part, unless specifically required for your internal use in responding to the Sourcing Process. You must not distribute any part of the Sourcing Process outside your organisation (including sub-contractors) without our prior written permission.
2. The unauthorised disclosure or use of any part of the Sourcing Process, or failure to observe any other requirements of the Sourcing Process will result in your immediate disqualification from further consideration.
3. All information in the Sourcing Process and any further information provided because of this Sourcing Process is to WWF-UK's reasonable knowledge and belief accurate at the time such information is provided. However, all such information may change over time and WWF-UK makes no representations or warranties concerning the completeness or accuracy of that information. All such information is provided only to indicate to you the scope of WWF-UK's requirements as a part of the Sourcing Process. You are solely responsible to undertake whatever investigation and due diligence you consider appropriate to verify the accuracy of any information provided to you.
4. All proposals, presentations and supporting materials submitted in response to this Sourcing Process will be treated by WWF-UK, its sub-contractors and advisers, as confidential and used solely for the purpose of selecting a Supplier as an outcome of the Sourcing Process or for a similar Sourcing Process in the future.
5. This Sourcing Process does not commit WWF-UK to any specific course of action. The issuance of this Sourcing Process does not bind WWF-UK to accept any proposal, in whole or in part.
6. WWF-UK will attempt to provide limited feedback to every unsuccessful participant in the Sourcing Process.
7. WWF-UK reserves the right to disqualify and reject proposals from potential suppliers who do not comply with any specified guidelines including adherences to WWF-UK policies for Suppliers as specified at [Supplier policies | WWF](#).
8. As part of this Sourcing Process WWF-UK makes no obligations in any way to:
 - a. pay any potential supplier for participating in this Sourcing Process; or
 - b. award any contract to the lowest price offered in this Sourcing Process; or
 - c. accept without qualification any information received as part of this Sourcing Process; or
 - d. include potential suppliers in any future sourcing process; or
 - e. make any other commitment to potential suppliers.
9. Potential suppliers acknowledge that damage alone would not be an adequate remedy for the breach of any of the provisions of these Sourcing Process Terms & Conditions. Accordingly, without prejudice to any other rights and remedies it may have, WWF-UK shall be entitled to the granting of equitable relief (including without limitation injunctive relief) concerning any threatened or actual breach of any of these provisions.

These Sourcing Process Terms & Conditions and any dispute or claim arising out of or in connection with them or their subject matter or formation (including non-contractual disputes or claims) shall be governed by and construed in accordance with English law. The courts of England and Wales shall have exclusive jurisdiction to settle any dispute or claim that arises out of or in connection with these Sourcing Process Terms & Conditions or their subject matter or formation (including non-contractual disputes or claims).
