

Opportunity to quote for the development of a Website and App offering information around accessibility of the University of Salford's buildings and teaching rooms

An issue faced by individuals with disabilities is not knowing what venues and services are accessible to their particular requirements.

This organisation provides that information on web pages that allow any potential visitor to plan their journey according to their needs. Confirming buildings are 'compliant' is one thing but communicating each building's facilities in a detail that individuals with disabilities find essential is another task altogether.

The service we require is the development of web pages and an App that provides detailed information about the access into and around all kinds of venues, including measurements and photographs. Each guide should be developed by a trained surveyor ensuring consistency of approach. All data published must be factual. The Access Guides must look at 'access' and 'disability' from lots of different perspectives - mobility impairment, learning disability, sensory impairment, dementia, and mental health.
