Frequently Asked Questions

Q. Will slides be shared after the event?

Q. Can you remind us of the portal you are using for the EOI?

Q. Will mental health issues be included within the disability category for this call?

A. Mental health issues can be considered a disability. The definition that is used by ESF is:

"You're disabled under the Equality Act 2010 if you have a physical or mental impairment that has a 'substantial' and 'long-term' negative effect on your ability to do normal daily activities."

Q. We work with young people and have identified that there could be a real issue with 19 – 25year olds working in the hospitality industry.

A. Young people are not a priority for this call as we are seeking to target the over50s but those young people with disabilities could be considered. Please come back to us about the specific definition for our disability output if you are interested in applying.

Q. Where does the 20% match funding need to come from? Is it restricted to the organisation's own funds or can it come from other funders?

- A. Match funding can come from other sources of funding provided they are **not** European funding sources. You could include some match funding in-kind for volunteers supporting the project delivery but a minimum of 10% will need to be cash. We have access to a match funding pot which is there to support applicants who are unable to find all the match funding they need. There is an application form that would need to be completed and you would need to demonstrate how your project would contribute to the wider Cornwall Economic Growth Strategy. We can also offer working capital loan assistance loans at 0% interest to support those projects in need of cashflow assistance to deliver their project.

Q. As it is likely that most of the delivery will need to be done remotely, certainly initially, using technology, based on the target demographic, are the individuals likely to have suitable technology?

- A. We have found that most people have a smart phone or have access to one but that the cost of data or WIFI access can be an issue for some. You would need to research this to establish access to technology within the target groups you would want to work with. Importantly you will need to demonstrate how you will find the people you want to engage with and persuade them that they would like to take part in your project.
