This modification notice details amending the Original Contract as follows:

Uplift the contract value by £22,725,000 from £45,450,000 ex VAT to maximum value of £68,175,000 ex VAT.

The minimum commitment will be £60 million. The Department commits to £60 million with a £68,175,000 maximum contract value based on consumption.

All other commercial terms are as per the original contract. Save as herein amended, all other terms and conditions of the Contract inclusive of any previous Variations shall remain in full force and effect.

We are unable to access another MOU or onboard another reseller without incurring a substantial cost increase of circa £5m for the final year of the service coverage Bytes (the reseller) provide a Cloud Investment Management Service and Quantum for Azure as significant value adds. Quantum is an analysis tool providing insights into Azure spend and usage which is not provided by other suppliers. The economic advantage is the 18% discount offered for year 4 against pricing secured 3 years ago. The MOU sourced from is no longer available and pricing has increased significantly (approx. 15%). As no MOU is currently accessible until summer

next year, we would need to contract as a single entity, removing any economies of scale previous benefit from.
