

ACCESS INFORMATION: World Museum Liverpool

Approach

Access is off Byrom Street


Approach along Byrom Street **OR** approach down Hunter Street.

Go under the Churchill Way Flyovers and immediately turn left up an un-marked back road (Cuerden Street), then first right of that road and you are in the car park.

This back road is **before** you reach the museum building,

If you end up in William Brown Street you are at the front of the building.

NB the museum has no special arrangement with the traffic wardens to allow free parking at its front entrance for cars and lorries.



Carpark

Main entrance to the carpark can accommodate vehicles up to 10 metres in length only, due to the curve on the approach.



Alternative access can be gained through the back gate for larger vehicles, but advanced notice is required as this entails closing off parking bays.



Loading bay

There is no flat access at the rear of the building, the height from the ground level to the loading bay is 1230mm. The vehicle tail-lift needs to be able to reach this height for off-loading or alternative arrangements need to be made in advance (i.e. hire of forklift vehicle).

The actual loading bay itself is H: 4953mm x W: 3835mm and is covered. We do have an overhead gantry system for offloading from open top vehicles, again notice is required as only certain members of staff have been trained in its usage.



There are static plastic strips separating the bay from the goods lift which can be slid across for easy off loading.



Goods lift

The goods lift can accommodate loads up to 4 tons; measuring H: 3000mm x W: 2460mm x L: 3900mm.

Access to Bughouse area, 2nd Floor

Access will be via the loading bay on the 2nd floor, and through the main bughouse area, to a set of double doors leading into the back end of the Bughouse.
